MARKING OF PERSONAL EQUIPMENT FOR CONVEYANCE IN BRAKE VANS ATTACHED TO TROOP TRAINS

Facks Will Not be marked in any way; but if required to be placed in brake wans will be securely labelled with an equipment label.

(d) RTO's at entraimment stations have been instructed to refuse brake van accomodation for any personal baggage which is not marked in accordance with this instruction.

MEN'S KITCHEN

The Men's kitchen is out of bounds to all ranks. The Orderly Sergeant is responsible to see that no personnel are in the kitchen after 1900 hrs. Any person found there after this time without authority, will be subject to disciplinary action.

DEMOBILIZATION: REPATRIATION CLAIMS

(a) It has come to notice that many members are applying for medical hourds on totally indequate grounds, in the belief that failure to record a repatriction claim now will jeopardice any claim that may be lodged in the futire.

(b) The Repatriation Dept has advised that there is no time limit within which a repatriation claim must be made for a pension and/or treatment. Such claim may be made at any time after discharge.

(c) Excessive claims of the nature referred to above will delay Demobilization Procedure.

DARWIN BEACHES : WARNING TO SWIMMERS

At the present time "Portugese Men-of War" are prolific off most Darwin beaches. This type of jolly fish is difficult to see in the water and consists of a semi-transparent body or float from which hang a number of stinging tentseles. The creature attacks with its tentseles, a sting from which will cause severe pain.

11. Another jelly fish which may be present in water around Darwin is the "Sea masp: This creature consists of a deep square shaped body approximately two inches across from which hang four stinging tentacles. The "Sea wasp" is highly dangerous and the sting has proved

111. Swimmers from the Darwin beaches are warned to exercise every care to avoid contact with the "Portugese Man-of-war and "See Wagp", and to refrain from entering the water what they are known to be present

Attention is also directed to the prevalence of sharks in parwin where due to the removal of the boon. Several large sharks have been caught recently in fish traps, and all ranks will exercise the utwass care when bathing. Sofuming in deep water is accordingly prohibited.
