26. VACATION OF CAMP SITE - LILYFIELD.

1. It is anticipated that the present HQ of this Depot will be vacated by Saturday 15 January 1947.
2. Each Section of HQ and Operations will be responsible to ensure that their respective areas, or buildings occupied by them, are left clean and tidy.
3. As the personnel situation is acute it will be the further responsibility of all ranks to assist in this regard as the alternative will be to arrange working parties in each Section on Sunday 19 January, 1947.

25. PRIVATE COMMUNICATIONS CONCERNING CASUALTIES. (MBI 170).

1. Private cables, telegrams and communications by air mail reporting casualties to members of the AMF are prohibited save and except where such communications are sent by a member relative to a casualty sustained by himself.
2. The prohibition imposed by para 1 hereof has been dictated by motives of consideration for the feelings of the relatives of members of the AMF to ensure that they will not receive inaccurate information from any unofficial source prior to receipt of authentic notification through official channels.

86. AASC SUPPLY DEPOTS AND TRANSPORT LINES - SECURITY. (MBI 182).

1. It is essential that all supply depots, transport lines and other establishments be guarded most rigidly and that information regarding the nature of supplies stored and stocks held be kept "secret."
2. Supply stores will be kept securely locked and will be entered only by authorized persons. All supply personnel will be excluded from stores other than those in which they have duty.
3. An inspecting officer will be provided with an authority to inspect (signed by an officer of the S & T Directorate of the command or military district) and will sign the Inspector's book on the occasion of each visit or tour of duty.
4. An inspector of the Finance Branch or of the Board of Business Administration will be in possession of an authority to inspect and an identification card, and will be required to sign the visiting inspector's book.
5. No officer or inspector will be permitted to walk about in any depot without first reporting to the HQ office and establishing his authority to have access to the depot.
6. It is essential that these rules be enforced rigidly to guard against the possibility of unauthorized collection of information, sabotage and theft. The possibility of impersonation will not be overlooked.
7. In all cases when personnel are permitted to enter supply stores, they will be accompanied by a member of the depot staff.
8. The same rules will apply to AASC vehicle lines, carb pump tanks and workshops.
9. It is the responsibility of the OC or senior NCO or private in charge of a supply depot, store, vehicle line, carb pump tank, workshop or other AASC establishment, as the case may be, to ensure compliance with the provisions of this instruction.

1. A unit paying officer or any representative will not make any payment that will cause the overdrawing of a member's pay book, except as set out hereunder:-

- (i) a member whose pay book is overdrawn may be paid within the limit of the restricted drawing rate which has been endorsed in the pay book by a representative of the District Finance Officer or Chief Paymaster;
- (ii) a paymaster may overpay a member to the extent of 75% of any estimated claim for travelling allowance on the written authority of the member's CO, and such overpayment will be adjusted by the member on payment of his claim for travelling allowance;
- (iii) a member proceeding on leave of more than 72 hours may be paid in advance against his credit earnings calculated to the date of expiration of such leave;
- (iv) a member may be paid in advance in special circumstances (for example, prior to embarkation or upon disembarkation) where such payment is authorised by instructions issued by HQ. In exceptional circumstances, an advance against the security of deferred pay may be made where the necessary approval has been obtained in accordance with instructions issued by the Chief Finance Officer.

MOVE TO NEW AREA - RANDWICK.

H Q 1 Sup Res Dep (including Operations and Transport) will move to Bundock Street, Randwick (Known as Old School of Artillery) recently vacated by 2 Labour Cp.

The move will be carried out by Section Control and will be completed by 1500 hrs Saturday 16 Jan '47.

Move will be by M.T. in accordance with arrangements made by 2 I/C. Sections will liaise with 2 I/C regarding this matter.

Leave of absence will NOT be granted on Sat. 16 Jan '47.

Rest day will be observed on Sunday 19 Jan '47 to all personnel other than those normally detailed for duty or in special circumstances as required.

Stores personnel other than those rostered for Stores duty will report to H Q to assist in the move to Randwick.

Arrangements have been made for majority of personnel to partake of mid-day meal at new address - Randwick. Provision will be made for a meal for the remainder at old Site Lilyfield.

Each Section will be responsible to ensure that their own areas and buildings are left clean and tidy.

HQ will arrange a Bear Duty consisting of a reliable NCO and 4 other personnel to check the Area. Special attention will be paid to Kitchen Stoves to make sure that all fires are drawn, and kitchens left clean.

Arrangements have been made with Camp Staff Officer to P 3 Old Area and install a caretaker on Saturday 16 Jan '47.

Officer accommodation will be in accordance with directions and plan issued separately.

C.M. will arrange with Camp Staff Officer to ensure that sufficient Fire equipment is left for Old Area.

The Secretary of Officers' and Sgts. mess will be responsible to ensure that their respective Mess' property and gear is satisfactorily moved and established in new area.

REM will liaise with Tpt. Officer to transport AWAS, living in personnel to AWAS Barracks, Burwood, at a time to be arranged on Saturday afternoon. Col. Doonan (AWAS) will be responsible to see that AWAS area at Lilyfield is left clean and tidy.

15. Should the Tram and Bus strike eventuate, Transport will be arranged by T.O. to pick up subsistence personnel in front of Customs House, Circular Quay at 0645 hrs and Car. Dental Clinic, Central Station at 0655 hrs.
16. All other personnel are expected to be on Parade at normal time at Randwick on Monday 20 Jan '47. Q.M. will arrange that sufficient blankets are available so that all other personnel can be accommodated on Sunday night 19 Jan '47. Breakfast will also be covered. RSM will ensure that all personnel are allocated to their respective quarters and are bedded down Sat. 18 Jan '47.
17. Petrol Bowser to be emptied by Sat. 18 Jan '47 and arrangements made by T.O. for the Bowser to be taken over by S. & T. (P.O.L). AAF F41 will be compiled by T.O. for quantity of petrol not able to be drawn off.

19. This H Q closes at Lilyfield 1200 hrs Saturday 19 Jan '47 and opens 1200 hrs same day at new area Randwick.

21. The Switchboard at Randwick will be manned on Saturday 18 Jan '47 from 1200 hrs to 1700 hrs and if necessary, on Sunday 19 Jan '47 from 0830 hrs to 1700 hrs.

(2) A unit paying officer or pay representative will not make any payment that will cause the overdrawing of a member's pay book, except as set out hereunder:-

- (i) a member whose pay book is overdrawn may be paid within the limit of the restricted drawing rate which has been endorsed in the pay book by a representative of the District Finance Officer or Chief Paymaster;
 - (ii) a paymaster may overpay a member to the extent of 75% of any estimated claim for travelling allowance on the written authority of the member's CO, and such overpayment will be adjusted by the member on payment of his claim for travelling allowance:-
 - (iii) a member proceeding on leave of more than 72 hours may be paid in advance against his credit earnings calculated to the date of expiration of such leave;
 - (iv) a member may be paid in advance in special circumstances (for example, prior to embarkation or upon disembarkation) where such payment is authorised by instructions issued by AHQ. In exceptional circumstances, an advance against the security of deferred pay may be made where the necessary approval has been obtained in accordance with instructions issued by the Chief Finance Officer.
19. MBI 170/46, is reproduced hereunder:-

Although application forms may have been completed by members still serving, for entitlement up to 2nd September, 1946, each member will complete a further application form (WGI) when passing through RR & GDD for discharge."

25. (1) Commanding Officers of Units are authorised to grant permission to personnel under their command to live out on subsistence if, in their opinion, the efficiency of the unit will NOT suffer in any way thereby.
- (2) Personnel absent from their home towns will receive the higher rate of subsistence, unless in the case of a married member, the wife is resident in the town adjacent to the place of the member's duty, notwithstanding the fact that the member is absent from his normal home town.

Details of rates of subsistence are:-

A. HIGHER RATE.

PERSONNEL WITH DEPENDENTS, the performance of whose duties prevent them living at home:-

Brigadiers and higher.....	8/6	per day, less 3/- Field Allowance.
Cols., Lt.-Cols and Majors	7/-	per day, less 3/- Field Allowance.
Capt's. and Lieuts.	6/-	per day, less 3/- Field Allowance.
WOI.	5/-	per day, less 1/- Field Allowance.
All other ranks	5/-	per day.

PERSONNEL WITHOUT DEPENDENTS, the performance of whose duties prevent them living at home.

All ranks 4/6 per day, less 3/- per day Field Allowance for Officers.

B. LOWER RATE.

PERSONNEL LIVING AT HOME.


All ranks 3/- per day.

Personnel receiving the high rate of subsistence will revert to the lower rate of 3/- per day, whilst on Recreation Leave.

3. FOOD COUPONS. - Food Coupons will be issued on a monthly basis to personnel living out on subsistence.

When unit transport is ordered by 1 Sup Res Dep personnel for the following day's requirements the request will be made per phone in the normal manner, but will be confirmed in writing to Transport Office immediately, confirming time and place that vehicle is to report.




