Cases have occurred in which telegrams lodged by personnel in N.O. have reached mainland addresses at dates SUBSEQUEST to Army advices to next of kin of the death in action of the soldier concerned. These occurrences have been the cause of great distress of mind, recipients of the delayed messages being given misplaced hope that in the circumstances the casualty telegram is in error.

To make clear to recipients the actual date of origin of telegrams from soldiers in N.G., it has accordingly been decided to require that the date e.g. 30 Jun be inserted after the signature in telegrams lodged by personnel. The date detail will be regarded as chargeable addition, and this is to be taken into account in assessing amounts to be collected from senders.

TO TIFICATION OF CHANGES IN REPORT OF MEXT OF KIN. (C.R.O. A.330 15 thep to 1. Amender of the AUT may nominate any person as his next of kin for

smy purposes, although that person is not his legal next of kin. 2. It is the function of the 2nd Schelen organization to notify fatal and certain other casulties sustained by a member to the person recorded in any records as the member's next of kin, or to any other person nominated

by such next of kin to receive casualty advices.

3. Failure by a member to report promptly particulars of a change of next of kin or a change of address of next of kin, in order that the appropriate 2nd Echelon component may be advised, causes considerable administrative work to the earny and may delay or prevent notification of a casualty being given to the proper person, therby causing distress to the member's relatives.

4. Each member will, therefore, be instructed that, on the occurrence of any event (such as his marriage or the death of his next of kin) which renders a change of the record of next of kin desirable or necessary, he will promotly notify his unit of the change he desires to made. Similar prompt no tification should be given of any change of address of his next of kin.

5. (a) Each member will be advised that, on his marriage, any will or codicil previously made by him, save in exceptional circumstances, becomes of no effect and, under Australian Military Regulations, he is bound,

upon marriage, to make a new will.

(b) On marriage, a member will make ano ther will immediately, either on an AAF A130 or by a separate document, and will submit the AAF A130 in an envelope (AAF Al31), duly completed, to his unit He for transmission to the appropriate 2nd Zohelon component.

(c) A member may obtain the assistance of an officer of the AALC in

the preparation of a will.
