



139. AUSTRALIAN KIT STORE - FUNCTIONS & PROCEDURE.

PROHIBITIONS.

(a) The deposit of the following articles in the Aust.Kit Store is prohibited.

arms, ammunition, personal & unit equipment, articles of enemy origin, articles of which at the time of deposit personnel were disintitiled to possession, explosives, spontaneously combustible or highly inflammable articles, matches, perishables, money, postal notes, canteen orders, securities, stamps, jewelry, precious metals & precious stones, watches, cameras, wireless sets & musical instruments: provided however that arms & other articles of personal equipment which have been issued to a member may be deposited at Aust Kit Store cloakroom.

(b) If it is discovered that a member of the AMF has deposited or caused to be deposited, live ammunition, explosives, spontaneously combustible, highly inflammable or perishable articles in Aust Kit Store, disciplinary action will be taken against that member wherever possible. If personnel who are not members of the AMF deposit or cause such articles to be deposited the facts in connection with the deposit will be reported to LHQ through normal channels.

140. USE OF CAMERAS.

All restriction on use of cameras in units under comd 11 Div are lifted providing that all cameras are registered with the O I/C Photography of the unit.

141. NATIVE VILLAGES.

All native villages are out of bounds except when operational or training requirements necessitate troops passing through such village.

142. USE OF EXPLOSIVES FOR FISHING.

1. Personnel will ensure that any natives other than those employed in authorised parties do not enter unit lines or surroundings.

2. Bathing with natives is forbidden. All troops who bathe in the mude will immediately don shorts or wrap a towel around themselves on leaving the water. This is necessary in order to preserve the desired relationship between Europeans and natives both now & postwar.

145. TRANSFER AND/OR DISCHARGE ON COMPASSIONATE GROUNDS SOLE SURVIVING MALE MEMBERS OF FAMILIES.

1. Further to para 9 of GRO 159/45 it is advised that an application for transfer on compassionate grounds will be approved, without regard to any other circumstances, where the soldier concerned is the sole surviving member of the family the others having been killed or having been officially classed as "Missing" or have been taken prisoners of war and not having been recovered.
2. If all the brothers of a member have been killed or have been taken prisoners of war or officially classed as missing but have not been recovered, the member will be deemed to be the sole surviving male member of his family for the purposes of the preceding para.
3. In cases of application for discharge on compassionate grounds, the fact that the soldier concerned is the sole surviving male member of the family, will be given special consideration, and, if the circumstances of the case cannot be met by transfer of the member, will be sufficient to warrant discharge on compassionate grounds.

146. CONSERVATION OF RUBBER - CRUDE AND SYNTHETIC TYRES.

1. Tyres in use in the field are now both of crude and synthetic construction and, as tyres of synthetic construction are far more susceptible to failure through abuse than tyres constructed from natural rubber, their introduction into the service has made it more imperative than ever that all instructions for care and maintenance of pneumatic tyres be strictly observed.
2. All concerned will therefore -
 - (i) exercise the utmost care to avoid all forms of tyre abuse, the principals of which are- overloading; under inflation; incorrect fitting of tyres; harsh breaking; fierce acceleration; speeds exceeding those laid down; driving over obstructions and other causes of severe impact.
 - (ii) check wheel alignment frequently and correct irregularities promptly.
 - (iii) ensure that tyres are changed around periodically in accordance with current instructions.
 - (iv) remove stones and flint from tyres during unit maintenance
 - (v) submit tyres for replacement at the correct stage for recapping
 - (vi) submit damaged tyres for repair without delay.
3. Formations and units will ensure that prompt disciplinary action is taken where breaches of this order occur

147. WEARING OF SHIRTS.

Personnel with the exception of cooks and welders will wear shirts at all times except for one hour daily when they may be removed for sunbaking.

148. DEMOBILISATION: LIVING OUT PERIODS.

Members permitted to live out will be informed of the date and time of their return but will be warned that this is subject to alteration, notification of which will be forwarded to them.

The period of living out will NOT be debited against any credits of leave.

149. DISENTITLEMENT TO SERVICE BENEFITS ON DISCHARGE.

If the employment of a member is terminated on disciplinary grounds or by reason of his conduct or discreditable service, the reason for such termination is entered in the members record and he is NOT entitled on discharge or termination of employment to various service benefits such as:

- (a) Leave prior to discharge or termination of employment.
- (b) Pay in lieu of such leave.
- (c) War service leave.
- (d) Supply of certain civilian clothing.
- (e) Retention of certain issue clothing.
- (f) Return of Active Service Badge.
- (g) General service badge.

150. ANGAU AREA-RABAUL. OUT OF BOUNDS.

The Angau Area Rabaul is out of bounds to all ranks except on official business.

151. ENGINES, SPARK IGNITION - FIRE HAZARD.

Attention of all ranks is drawn to the danger of priming petrol engines by pouring liquid into induction manifolds. In addition to this practice being harmful to cylinder bores, piston rings and valve guides, grave fire risk is involved which has in the past been responsible for loss of life, valuable equipment and painful injuries to personnel.

The introduction of petrol into the inlet manifold of a petrol engine by removing the air cleaner and pouring the petrol through the carburettor air intake will most likely be resorted to as an emergency.

Not more than approximately one tablespoon of petrol will be introduced by this method.

Under no circumstances will any attempt be made to start the engine until the air cleaner has been replaced.

152. AUSTRALIAN ARMY CANTEEN SERVICE.

The Australian Army Canteen Service distributed out of profits accumulated from the inception of the service to 31 Dec. 44 the following amounts.

The amount of profits accumulated at 31 Dec. 44 but as yet undistributed totals £2,409,843 and is used as capital to finance the business of the service. The Canteens Service Regulations provide that, at the winding up of the service, the fund of accumulated profits is to be vested in trustees to be appointed by the minister for the benefit of members and ex members of the military forces and their dependants or the dependants of deceased members the intention being to provide for those cases of hardship which do not fall within the necessarily exact definitions of the Repatriation Laws.

153. POST DISCHARGE - MALARIA.

1. (a) The Repatriation Commission will accept responsibility for providing any treatment necessary in respect of the first attack of malaria suffered by an ex member of the AMF after his discharge from the army.
(b) During such treatment, the Commission will institute inquiries as to eligibility or otherwise for the treatment of any subsequent attacks of malaria.
2. On the first occasion after his discharge that an ex member becomes ill with malaria, he should:
 - (i) if resident in a capital city report to the Repatriation Depts branch office or general hospital, either in person or by telephone, when immediate examination and treatment will be arranged.
 - (ii) if resident in the country report to the nearest Repatriation local medical officer, who will send a report to the Repatriation Dept. It will be necessary for the ex member to identify himself by the production of his discharge certificate.
3. (a) If it is not possible to report, the ex member should consult and request treatment from his local civilian doctor, and, provided prompt advice is sent by the doctor or the ex member to the Repatriation Dept, the Commission will assume full responsibility for the payment of medical fees, hospital fees and the cost of drugs.
(b) Arrangements for any further treatment will be notified to the ex member by the Repatriation Commission as soon as possible.
4. Information regarding the treatment of malaria, with particular reference to ex service personnel, has been sent by the Commonwealth Dept. of Health to civil medical practitioners.
5. In view of the foregoing, it is unnecessary for any member to be examined by a final medical board at the time of his discharge merely on account of a history of malaria. If the member has had an attack during his service, it will be on record in his medical history. Whether or not the member has had an attack during his service, he will be cared for by the Repatriation Commission should he develop an attack of malaria after his discharge.

154. DISPOSAL OF MAIL MATTER PERSONNEL PROCEEDING ON LEAVE OR BEING DISCHARGED.

1. Complications have arisen in the past because mail matter for soldiers on leave, discharge etc has been re/directed to home address contrary to the soldiers wishes.
2. Accordingly units will ensure that the following procedure is adopted:
 - (a) Before marching out on leave or discharge etc each soldier will be required to fill in a card APS17 indicating the address to which he desires mail to be redirected.
 - (b) Postal orderlies will act only on information recorded on APS17. On no account will mail matter be directed to soldiers home address unless authority in writing from the soldier concerned is held by the Unit Postal Orderly.
 - (c) Re/addressing of mail matter by units to CDDs is not permitted unless there is some very special reason for contrary action.
 - (d) All personnel concerned must be given clearly to understand that mail matter will be redirected to one address only and that no discrimination whatever as to items to be so addressed will be undertaken by Army Postal Services. The sole responsibility for redirection instructions relating to the forwarding of mail matter will be that of the individual concerned.

155. DESPATCH OF SOUVENIRS ETC. THROUGH POSTAL CHANNELS.

In stances have recently been reported of tps in New Britain despatching souvenirs through postal channels without the certificate required by GRC 209/45. Such certificate must be att'd to the souvenir and is the owners authority for possessing the article. In addition all parcels must contain a slip showing the number name and unit of sender.

The attention of all tps is drawn to GRC 383/44 which prohibits the despatch of ammunition etc through postal or other channels.

Failure to comply with the above instructions may render parcels liable to confiscation.

156. SECURITY OF STORES OF AN ATTRACTIVE NATURE.

Officers and other ranks entrusted with stores of an attractive nature are personally responsible for any loss occurring by reason of their own negligence.

Comds will ensure that this responsibility is clearly made known to all such personnel.

Pistols will be carried in accordance with instructions issued by competent authority. When not being carried in the course of duty, pistols will be handed to Unit Q store for custody or kept in a locked box.

Where by usage of constant usage it is not practicable for the holder of a pistol to hand it in to unit Q store, and no other locking facilities are available, he will take the utmost care to avoid the possibility of theft. In particular pistols will not be left lying on tables or in other places where they are readily visible.

Matches will be kept in the immediate personal possession of the personnel to whom they are on issue. They will not be left lying on tables or in other places where they are readily visible.

Other stores of an attractive nature, such as compasses and binoculars will be handed in to unit Q store for custody when not in actual use.

157. FINAL MEDICAL BOARDS.

Applications for final medical boards are being made on wholly inadequate grounds in the belief that the failure to make a claim for repatriation now will invalidate any future claim.

As an excessive number of such applications will slow down demob procedure, the following facts will be brought to general notice -

(a) There is no time limit within which a claim for repatriation must be lodged.

(b) Such claim may be lodged at any time after discharge.

(c) A negative answer to para 7 of AAF D2(a) does NOT prejudice any future claim for a war pension by the member.


