62. WAR SOUVENIRS - POLICE

1. Personnel are permitted to possess or send to their nominated addressees, but not to Aust Kit Stores, as war souvenirs, items of enemy equipment and documents which are of no value to Intelligence or Ordnance, but they are not permitted to possess or return the following:-

Pistols, Rifles and Bayonets
SMGs, LMGs, and HMGs
Grenade dischargers
Mortars
Field, mountain, A tk and AA artillery sights
technical equipment and parts
Grenades, ammunition and explosives
Mines, Flamethrowers, Rangefinders
or any original item (unless authorized by Intelligence)

2. Personnel desirous of retaining or returning to their nominated addressees items of enemy equipment (other than those specified above), as war souvenirs will present such material to their formation Intelligence officer for inspection. Any person not wishing further information will contact orderly room.

63. JAPANESE EQUIPMENT DUMPS.

1. On no account will troops be permitted to have access to Japanese stores and equipment dumps guarded by Allied or Japanese guards.

2. All souvenirs will be issued under proper supervision to those personnel desiring them, who are covered by written authority. The final decision regarding the disposal of awards is not yet available from LMG. On receipt such information will be promulgated.

64. WAR SERVICE LEAVE

1. War service leave has been approved for service 2 in New Guinea and Mandated Territory. Leave will be at the rate of 7 1/2 days for each six months of the members total qualifying service if such service exceeds six months. An odd period of more than four months in the total period will count as six months. The qualifying period is from the date of embarkation to date of disembarkation.

65. R.F.M. SERVICE BETWEEN AUSTRALIA, PAPUA AND NEW GUINEA

1. Notification is given of the immediate commencement of the above service, which also included Solomon Is. Standard text messages only will be excepted at the rate of 2/6 per telegram

2. Senders of messages should consult the lists of texts available at Base Post Office or any F.P.O.
