1. GENERAL:

H.T. "DUNTROON" has been made available to load personnel, vehicles and stores as shown in Appendix "A" attached.

2. UNIT EQUIPMENT, ACCOMMODATION STORES:

H.Q., Q'land. L. of C. Area will ensure that Units move with sufficient stores, including tentage, to provide coverage at destination.

3. SHIP'S STAFF:

(a) A Permanent Ship's Staff is on board who will detail the necessary details for the voyage.

(b) Advance Party as required will board the vessel at a time and date to be notified by E.S.O.

4. MARKING OF CARGO AND STORES:

Stores will be marked in accordance with "STANDING ORDERS FOR MOVEMENTS WITHIN AUSTRALIA AND ITS TERRITORIES - SECS XI AND XV".

5. PREPARATION OF VEHICLES:

(a) Vehicles will be prepared in accordance with "STANDING ORDERS FOR MOVEMENTS WITHIN AUSTRALIA AND ITS TERRITORIES - SEC XIV Part B".

(b) Windscreens of Jeeps will be removed before shipment to obviate breakage.

6. CONCENTRATION AND LOADING OF STORES AND VEHICLES:

(a) Stores and Vehicles will remain in Unit Areas until called forward by Port M.C.O., represented by Major MORROW.

(b) No dangerous or inflammable cargo will be loaded.

(c) Before sailing, C.T.O. will inspect chocking of all Vehicles.

7. CONCENTRATION OF PERSONNEL:

Personnel will remain in present Camp Areas.

8. MOVEMENT TO WHARF:

(a) Personnel will move from Camp Areas to wharf by M.T. under arrangements H.Q., Q'land. L. of C. Area.

(b) Time and date to be notified by Movement Control.

9. PROVOST:

(a) Four (4) Provost Personnel are to be at the wharf during embarkation under arrangements H.Q., Q'land. L. of C. Area.

(b) On arrival at wharf they will report to E.S.O. for instructions.

107. EMBARKATION.

- (a) Embarkation will take place under the supervision of E.S.O., Lieut. YATES, in accordance with "STANDING ORDERS FOR MOVEMENTS WITHIN AUSTRALIA AND ITS TERRITORIES - SECS XV AND XVI".
- (b) On arrival at wharf, Unit Commanders will form up personnel in Nominal Roll order to facilitate checking by Records Staff at Ship's gangway.
- (c) No personnel will leave the ship after embarkation except with the permission of the E.S.O.
- (d) Unauthorised personnel, animals, explosives and intoxicating liquors will not be embarked, or taken on board.
- (e) Attention is drawn to the fact that smoking is NOT permitted on the wharf.

11. RATIONS AND RESERVE SUPPLIES:

Under arrangements H.Q., Q'land. L. of C. Area, all ranks embarking will be supplied with the following:-

- (a) One (1) Emergency Ration (carried on the man).
- (b) First Port - One (1) day's Landing Rations (less P.O.L.) shipped in bulk as Unit Stores.  
Second Port - Three (3) days' Landing Rations (less P.O.L.) shipped in bulk as Unit Stores.

12. MEDICAL:

A permanent S.M.O. is on board the ship.

13. DOCUMENTATION:

- (a) Documentation will be in accordance with 3 Aust. M.C. Gp's. "STANDING ORDERS FOR EMBARKATION" and "SHIPPING PROCEDURE AS RELATING TO SERVICE CARGO".
- (b) Six (6) copies of Nominal Rolls and six (6) copies of A.A.F. T.51s as above will be prepared and forwarded to E.S.O. at a time and date to be notified.

14. CANTEN SUPPLIES:

Units will ensure that personnel embarking have sufficient tobacco and cigarettes for the voyage.

15. SECRECY:

The necessity for strictest secrecy in connection with this movement must be impressed on all concerned.


