 - (ii) seating accommodation, NOT exceeding five (5) including the driver, is filled.
 - (iii) trailers are NOT used for carrying personnel.
- (d) Approval is in all cases given by an officer and his endorsement to that effect is made on the Work Ticket.

This endorsement will be signed by the authorising officer and by the officer, NGO or senior soldier in charge of the party.

- (f) Army transport will NOT be authorised for amonity runs for any distance less than one mile.
- (g) Specialist vehicles, motor cycles and motor cycle combinations will NOT be used for amenity runs.
- (h) Drivers detailed for amenity runs will:-
 - (i) Be the drivers regularly allocated to the vehicles used.
 - (ii) Be in possestion of a proper Work Ticket duly made out.
 - (iii) Be on duty from the time the vehicle leaves the MT Park until the vehicle returns to the park.
 - (iv) NOT consume alcohol whilst on duty.
 - (v) NOT exceed the speed limit of the vehicle or the local limits laid down.

Precautions

- 1. Dress:
 - (a) Service Personnal: During the hours between dusk and dash, personnal must war a uniform which conforms to the following restrictions and which affords the minimum exposure of BKIM. Dreas will include, long-sleeved shirt or jacket with sleaves down and slacks, books, boots or shees but not necessarily anklets will be worn, then wearing civilian dreas, as autorised by FRO 69 of 21 May 47, the precautions set out above vill apply.
 - (b) <u>Gyullans</u>: Guilians will conform to the prequitions as far as in practicable, shacks and blouses or shirts with long sleeves should be worn. If an occasion should arise hen civilians are unable to conform to these instruction, then the precaution of as ing mosquito repositant will be adopted.
- 2. Mosfulto Repellent: Mosfulto repellent will be issued to all service personnel of the BOOF and to all oivilians under control of the BOOF. Repellent will be used by all personnel as directed within the various formations and units areas.
