40. "BRITISH BATTLE DRESS" - NOT TO BE WORN.

- 1. Wearing of the type of uniform known as "British Bettle Dress" is an infringement of A.I.F. (M.E.) Orders in which is laid down Order of Dress for the A.I.F.
- 2. Wearing of "British Battle Dress" will cease forthwith and any disregard of this order will be treated as a matter for disciplinary action.

41. LOSS AND PILFERING OF GOVERNMENT PROPERTY.

- 1. Examination by censorship has revealed that parcels despatched by members of the A.I.F. to relatives and friends contain articles classified as loot and also Government property.
- 2. This practice will cease forthwith and disciplinary action will be taken against both the sender of the parcel and the franking officer, when breaches are detected.
- 3. In this regard it is stressed that extra unit censorship has recently been greatly extended.
- 4. It is forbidden to despatch to any private address, any article of Government property or loct in the form of captured enemy clothing, material of any type including live ammunition and explosives, or documents, books or any other articles of value to the Intelligence Service in determining identification and acquiring information regarding the enemy.
- 5. Objects which are only curios or souvenirs and are of no military value may be despatched.
- 6. Attention is drawn to AIF (ME) Orders Nos.236 of 7 Mar.1941 and 516 of 26 July 1941.

52. WASTAGE OF PETROL.

- Considerable wastage of petrol is incurred through :-
 - (a) Filling vehicle tanks from pumps at a rate which causes air locks and over-flowing.
 - (b) Drivers of vehicles insisting upon their vehicle tanks being filled to over-flowing both at pumps and from containers.
- 2. The driver is responsible for supervising the refuelling of his vehicle. A reasonable degree of care will obviate all losses from too rapid filling from pumps. Filling vehicle tanks to over-flowing is deliberate maste.
- Notices to this effect will be posted up at all points at which petrol 3. is assued at Petrol Pumps in unit lines.

53. FLY CONTROL IN THE MIDDLE BAST.

- The fly is the chief cause in the spread of dysentry and other deseases of the expresental type. These diseases are a serious cause of inefficiency and the prevention of the fly is of paremount importance in reducing their incidence.
- The fly season is approaching and it is imperative that all units should realise their responsibilities in regard to the prevention of flies and should discharge these to the best of their shillity.
- 3. In this connection the following principles are of importance :-
 - (a) The prevention of fly breeding in camps, barracks, and their environs depends basically upon adequate camp sanitation and cleanliness.
 - (b) Strict control of the disposal of all waste matters, including human and animal excrete, refuse, garbage and swill is essential.
 - (c) The utmost care must be exercised is order to protect all food, and cooking, eating and drinking utensils, from contemination by flies.
 - (d) Everything possible should be done to ensure trapping or destruction by other means of adult flies.
- 4. All ranks will co-operate in these measures to the maximin extent possible. All units are reminded of the assistance which can be obtained from the medical authorities, especially in this respect from Field Rygiene Sections.

(CR/ME/3113/M - G.0.367).

54. PARCELS - U.K.

 - (a) and (b) are M.T. oils supplied entirely from abroad. (c) is produced locally and costs only about one-third of the present market price in Egypt of waste M.T. oil.
- 2.It has now been desided that in order to economize in shipping space, waste M.T. oils will be handed over to oil refining companies for regomeration and re-issued for further use.
- 3. The use of M.T. oils for sanitary, cooking and other purposes will cease forthwith -
 - (a) In base and L.of C.areas where fuel oil should always be available from D.I.D.'s on demand.
 - (b) In forward areas if fuel oil is obtainable.
- 4. The proceedure for recovery of waste M.T. oils is as follows:-
 - (a) All waste M.T.oils will be collected and handed over either direct to Salvage Depots or Salvage Units or via Petrol, Depots in capty returning transports.
 - (b) Waste engine and gear oil will be collected in separate containeds. A mixture of the two grades camot be successfully regenerated, and would therefore represent a complete maste of effort.
 - (e) Waste engine oil from sumps will be collected in empty drums which have previously contained M.160 or M.220.
 - (d) Taste gear and axle oils will be collected together in drums which have previously contained C.600.
 - (e) Drums containing used oils will be securely stoppered and the greatest care must be taken by units to distinguish between:-
 - (i) Drums of new M.T.oil.
 - (ii) Drums of waste M.T.oil.
 - (iii) Drums of fuel oil.
 - Disciplinary action will be taken in every case where this Order is not complied with.
