Further interpretation of photographic recommissance carried out on 11 May showed an airfield with three runways to be under construction one kilometre south-west of Kastelli.

No shipping was observed in the sea areas north of the Peloponnes, north of Grete and between the African coast and the southern tip of Kythura.

At 0950 hours a battleship of 13,000 tons moving at high speed on an easterly course was observed 70 km south-east of Hhodes.

At 1625 hours four destroyers and three heavy oruisers moving at high speed on a north-westerly course were observed 80 km south of Gavdos

At 1650 hours two battleships and eight destroyers on a northwesterly course were observed in the same area.

Between 0515 and 0700 hours twelve dive-bombers attanked shipping 19 May: in Suda Boy. A hit with a 500 kg back was source on a cruiser of the York' dama. Eccorting fighters set on fire three Hurriennes on the ground at Malone airfield and apparently damaged six others extensively. Six guns were siloneed by a direct hit on an AA position.

20 May: In the early sorming recommainsance was carried out over the entire sea around Grete. No enemy shipping was observed.

At 0750 hours recommaissance observed two medium merchant ships on fire and a destroyer at anchor in Soda Bay. A heavy cruiser moving at full speed on a north-westerly course was observed 150 km south of Gavido Ialand.

20 Mar: At 0550 hours alavam light bombers attacked Iraklion airfield and nearby Ad and machine sum positions. Hits were also scored on fuel dumps.

In addition, Al positions west of Malane and at Games were attacked by eighteen and twenty-eight dire-bambers respectively. Most of the Ak guns in the areas which were attacked were put out of action, as there was no Ak five after the openrich and been carried out.

An airborne operation against Grete with bomber and fighter support was launched at 0600 hours, the sain areas of attack being Maleme and Ganes. The operation is proceeding seconding to plan.

Between 0700 and 0930 hours a further 59 bombers attacked tent encompanents and AA positions in the area Maleme - Canas and signals installations in the area Canas - Rethinson - Iroklion - Ierapetra fourtherm cost).

Between 1125 and 1145 hours fifteen bombers soored direct hits on artillary positions at Irabian. Only two gams were still firing after the attack.

Alikianou was occupied by German troops at 1300 hours.

Ships in Sada Bay were dive-bombed at 1340 hours. Direct hits were soured on ships and AL positions in the southern part of the bay.

21 May: Energy remistance in the bunkers on the castern edge of Malance sirriald has been broken. The area to the ment is clear of the energy. Aircord's have been able to use the mirriald since 0750 hours. Energy night attacks at Galakam were Griven off.

Gorman attacks on Iraklian airfield have been in progress since 0630 hours. German troops are advancing on the team of Iraklian. The airfield and town of Schimson are in German hands.

In the early morning energy cruisers and light warmhing in the sed area west of Crete (between Crete and Artilytharm) noved into the Acgean. Borry destroyers appoared off Fueldion. These warmhings within Amba a hurried withdrawal from the sea area north of Crete, have been under air attack since 600 hours.

Elements of the Iroklion group forced their way into the town and evacuated again after mopping up.

The Talian securit intercepted the attack and saved the transports. In this action an Italian targedo back scored too hits and save affitish entiace.

Towards moon a second energy formation attampted to move into the sea area morth of Drete from the south-west.

Energy nevel forces in the Grete area comprise four battleships, twolve cruisers and eighteen destroyers, most of which were located between 75 and 160 im wort of Crete during the day. In addition, an aircreftearrier was believed to be between Grets and Morth Africa.

22 May: Bombers and dive-bombers were sent out to attack the enony warships noving towards Grote and into the Asgear. According to reports received so far the following results were achieved:

- 2 cruisers and 1 destroyer sunk,
- 1 battleship and 3 gruissrs damaged,
- 5 warships (type not stated) and
- 1 merchant ship hit (results not observed).

During the midday period the energy formation retired in a southwesterly direction under the effect of these attacks.

In addition to the attacks on shipping, bankers, dive-bankers and single-engined and twim-engined fighters supported ground troops on Drote by attacking enany strong-points, artillery and anti-bank positions and tanks, particularly in the Malmo area.

At midday three battleships, six cruisers and twolve destroyers on course for Alexandria were observed about 230 km south-east of Grete.

At 1511 hours two cruisers on a north-easterly course were observed about 300 km south of the eastern tip of Grete.

No energy shipping was obsorved in the sea area Crute by recommaissonce carried out north of the 34th parallel until 1900 hours. There are believed to be two small formations of light warships in the area south of the 34th parallel.

There are no indications of attempts to disemberk British troops on the southern coast of Grete.
