Middle line. Heaven's favour was with the Allied Nations as the weather cleared up and became ideal for attack from the air.

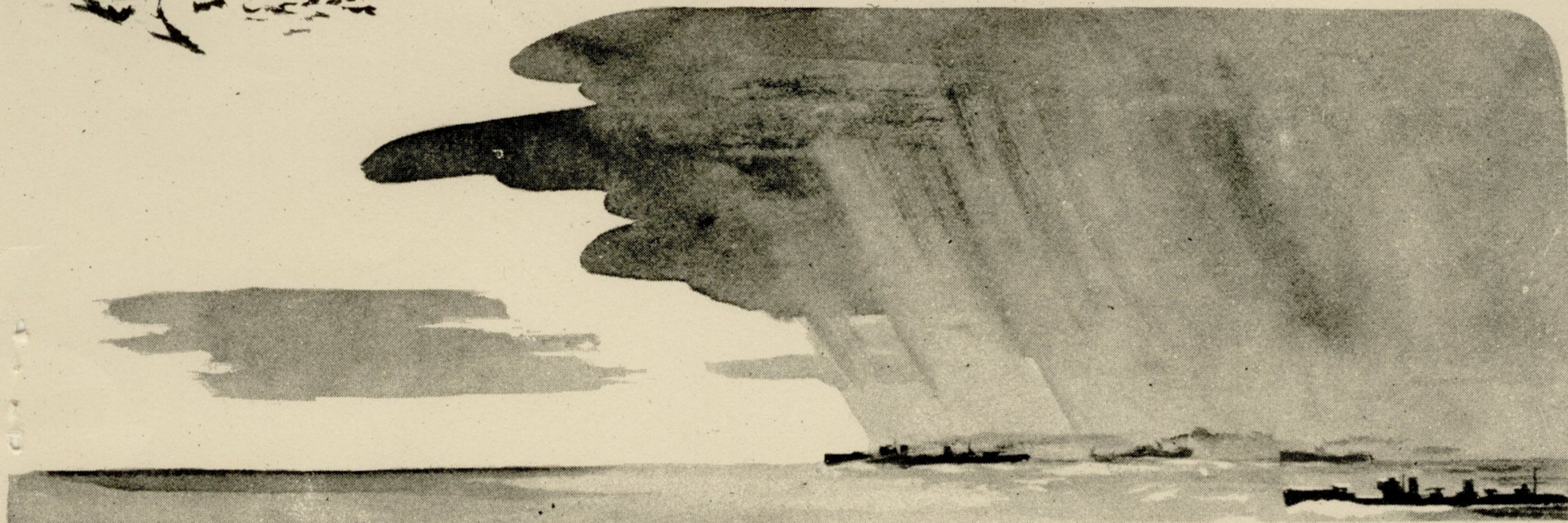
Bottom line. Total results of the fight:

Warships 10 ships. Transports 12 ships.

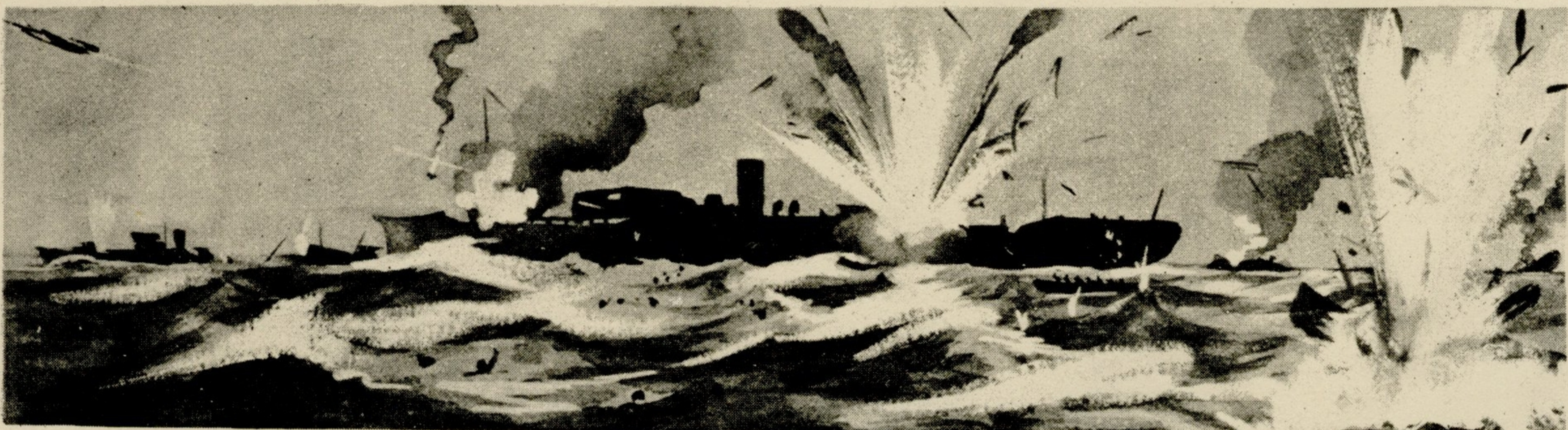
Bombers and fighters 102 planes

Men officers and soldiers 15,000.

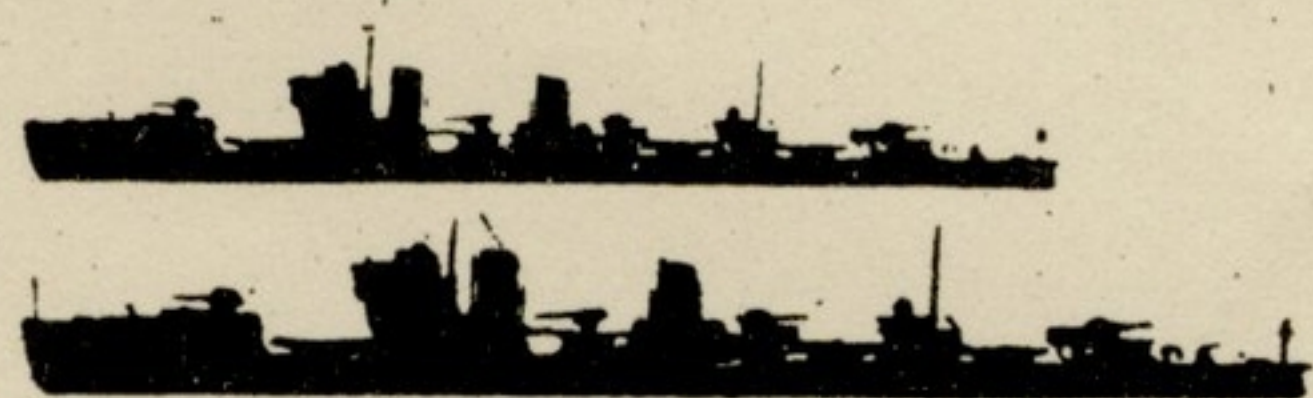

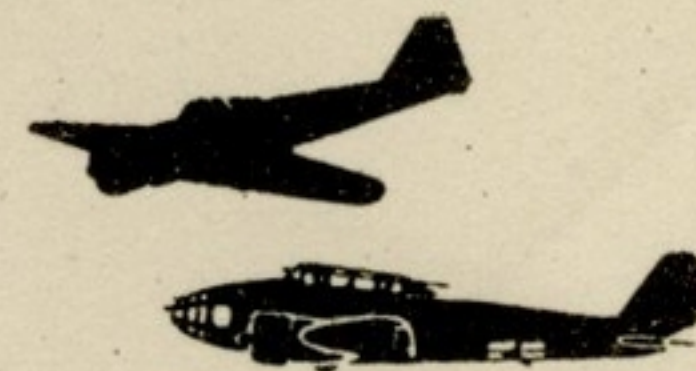

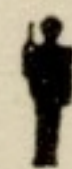
