The (Japanese) military clique and self-styled patriots responsible for the present war continuously repeat the argument that overpopulation justifies foreign conquest by war.

The truth is different.

Hokkaido is underpopula ted and could support several million more Japanese settlers. Year after year the Hokkaido Governor complained that the Tokyo authorities were neglecting the northern provinces and that no settlers were forthcoming.

The fallacy of the Japa nese overpopulation problem is further illustrated by the course of events in Manchuria. Since seizing that country the military clique has made great efforts to attract young Japanese agricultural settlers, bringing all kinds of pressure to bear in Japan. Using the Reservists League, they even resorted to compulsory emigration in many cases. Despite this pressure, permanent settlers now - after twelve years, number only around 300,000. Of course this figure does not include Korean immigrants nor Japanese personnel of the South Manchuria Railway and other temporary Japanese residents connected with the industries.

This is the record of Japanese emigration to Manchuria, a sparsely populated country three and a half times as large as Japan Proper. The density of population in Manchuria is less than 40 per square mile. In other territories under Japanese domination the position is similar: Korea has only 700,000 and Formosa 300,000 Japanese inhabitants and in both countries the number of permanent settlers is very small.

The reason for this is not only that Japan is a beautiful land and that the Japanese find it hard to go away from home, but also that there is no real need for them to emigrate:

The food shortage (in Japan) resulting from lack of shipping is now the talk of the day. But the cultivated area within the country could easily be increased by 20% and more, if only the necessary manpower on the land were available. There is irony in the fact that Japan now suffers from a shortage of labour and has to import workmen and farm-hands from Korea and China.

If only a fraction of the national wealth now being wasted like bathwater by the military clique had been spent on the development of Hokkaido and on improvement of rural and industrial conditions in other parts of the country, overcrowding in cities could have been avoided and national loyalty would have been fulfilled. Japan could have become a model country and a respected member of the family of nations.

(But) the ambition of the military leaders is ruining Japan.
