MANILA HAS FALLEN

American troops entered Manila, capital of the Philippines, on February 3, 1945.

This was 25 days after they landed in Lingayen Gulf and General Yamashita declared that the American forces would soon be annihilated and that he was not concerned about the outcome of

the fighting in the Philippines.

When the Japanese captured Manila on January 2, 1942, they gained entrance to all the Philippines and the Southern regions. Now the key city is lost, and the way from Japan to the South is in imminent danger of being completely closed.
