TO OFFICERS AND MEN OF THE JAPANESE FORCES:

Under the Geneva Convention, Prisoner of War Camps in Australia and elsewhere are regularly inspected by an officer from a neutral country. Naturally the favourable reports of our treatment of the 9700 officers and men now in our care have reached Japanese authorities. They send money to Australia for extra comforts for these prisoners. 83,000 Yen have been provided this time by Japan, asking that it be divided carefully between Prisoners of War and Internees.

In what grateful tears these men think of their country and then give thanks that their lives were spared so that they might serve their homeland when the war is ended is needless to add here.
