BAILLEUL.	March 3rd		<p>During the month I inspected all Units under my administration.</p> <p><u>Condition</u> of animals is excellent right throughout the Division. A marked improvement is noticeable in the condition of Artillery Units, 7th and 8th A.F.A. Brigades, which at the beginning of the year were not at all satisfactory.</p> <p><u>Forage</u> throughout the month has been good in quality. The reduction of 2lbs of Oats per animal effected during the month has not affected the working condition of animals.</p> <p><u>Watering</u> conditions have been very good.</p> <p><u>DISEASE.</u></p> <p>Three cases of Suspected <u>Stomatitis Contagiosa</u> were under observation, but fortunately fears of an outbreak were groundless.</p> <p><u>Mange</u> is practically non-existent.</p> <p><u>Ophthalmia</u> has caused trouble generally. For the month 42 cases were admitted for treatment and 13 evacuated to L.of.C. Reference treatment of same. I have obtained the best results from the use of LUGOLS SOLUTION.</p> <p><u>MOB. VET. SECTION.</u> During the month received 116 animals; of these 106 were evacuated, and 10 returned to Units. Of 116 animals received, 39 were from Other Formations.</p> <p>Inspection by A.D.V.S. Australian Corps, was held of all Artillery Units in the Division and an excellent report given on condition of animals and stable management.</p> <p>Divisional Headquarters 3rd Australian Division.</p> <p>D.A.D.V.S. 3rd Australian Division.</p>
