

AILLEUL.	March 3rd		During the month I inspected all Units under my administration.	
			Condition of animals is excellent right throughout the Division. A marked improvement is noticeable in the condition of Artillery Units,7th and 8th A.F.A.Brigades, which at the beginning of the year were not at all satisfactory.	
			Forage throughout the month has been good in quality. The reduction of 21bs of Oats per animal effected during the month has not affected the working condition of animals.	
			Watering conditions have been very good.	
			DISEASE.	
			Three cases of Suspected Stomatitis Contagiosa were under observation, but fortunately fears of an outbreak were groundless.	
			· Mange is practically non-existent.	
			Ophthalmia has caused trouble generally. For the month 42 cases were admitted for treatment and 13 evacuated to L.of.C. Reference treatment of same. I have obtained the best results from the use of LUGOLS SOLUTION.	
			MOB. VET. ASECTION. During the month received 116 animals; of these 106 were evacuated, and 10 returned to Units. Of 116 animals received, 39 were from Other Formations.
