



The condition of the animals in the Division remains good in spite of the severe work during the week.

Of 85 Remounts received during the week the H.D., L.D. and Mules were satisfactory, but the riding horses were of poor type.

Wastage for the week is higher, due chiefly to Battle Casualties, the percentage of wastage for the week being - Horses 1.3% Mules 2.82%

Veterinary Report for week ending 26/9/18.

Although, owing to the heavy work demanded of the transport during the past and the previous weeks, certain animals have falled away slightly in condition, the condition of animals in the Division is good; the animals being in hard working condition and well muscled.

Wastage during the week is lower than during the previous week, the percentage of wastage being - Horses .94% Mules .45%

The number of cases admitted to treatment during the week shews a slight increase on the previous week's figures. The increase is mainly represented by cases of Picked up Nails, Battle Casualties, and by cases of harness galls; the latter cases occurring in the two Artillery Brigades. Enquiry into the cause of these cases of harness galls is now being made so that efficient measures can be adopted to prevent their occurrence in future.

Cases treated during the week are summarised as follows :-

General Diseases. 2 cases Fever admitted and cured.

Digestive. 1 Colic admitted and remaining under treatment.

Lymphatic. 1 Lymphangitis admitted and remaining.


