

LOCATION AND RAILHEAD Same as for last month.

Owing to the Division being in rest, work for the month has been very light. About 12 lorries each day draw supplies for Divisional Troops, all other supplies are drawn by horse transport.

The number of loads of various kinds carted for the month is 1045, and the total mileage run is 23791.

Advantage has been taken of the rest to get the lorries in good running order, the Workshops have been busy, and many minor repairs, which had we been busy would have been held over, have been completed.

Leave has been granted freely to the men both to the United Kingdom and Paris.

Excellent weather has prevailed, and sports of all kinds have been indulged in.

On several occasions the Column Band has played at Corps and Divisional Headquarters.

The food and clothes have been good and plentiful.
