

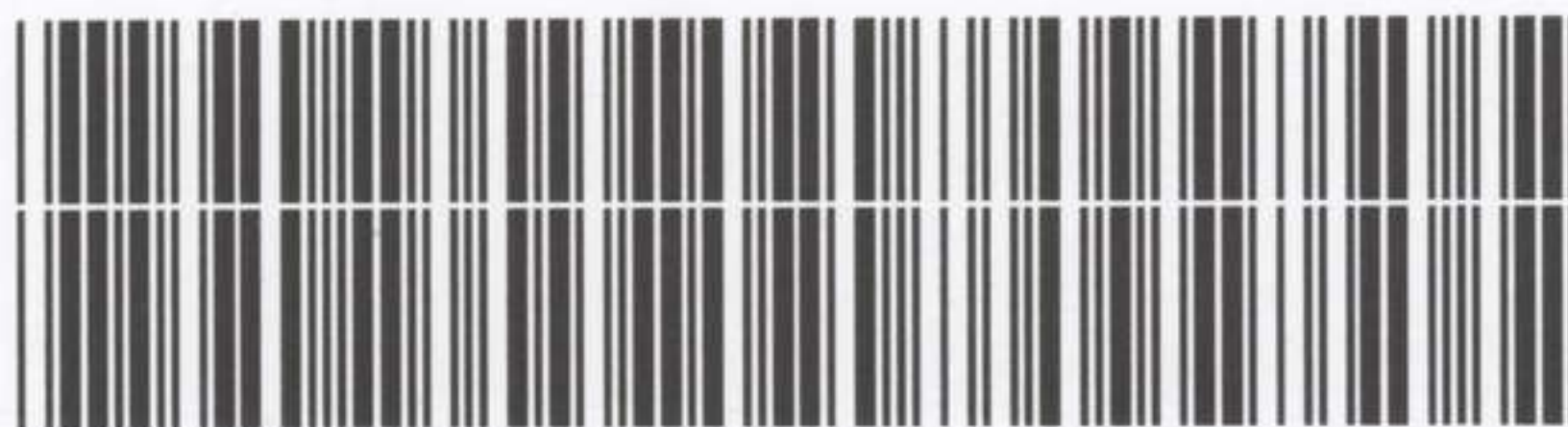

Loading Time. On 18/1/16, the Official loading time, as furnished by the R.T.O. and Supply Officers, showed that this Unit had loaded up supplies for approximately 20000 troops in 33 minutes, by which time the last lorry had moved out of the Station Yard. This performance constitutes a record for France.
