

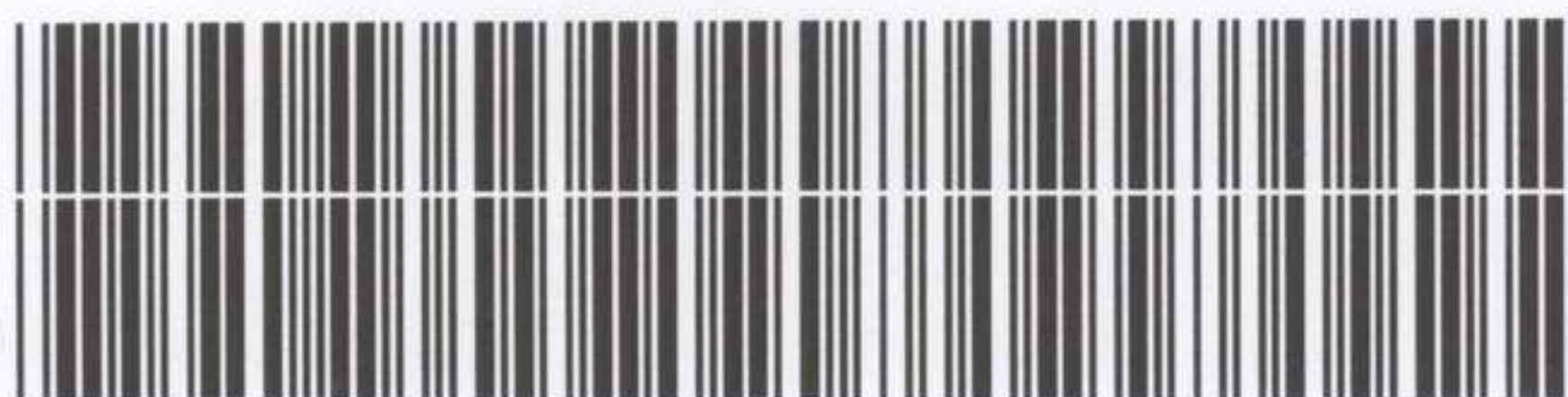

There did several weeks of course laid down for Infantry, and completed musketry course, as well as doing a small amount of bombing, & trench work. | |
