

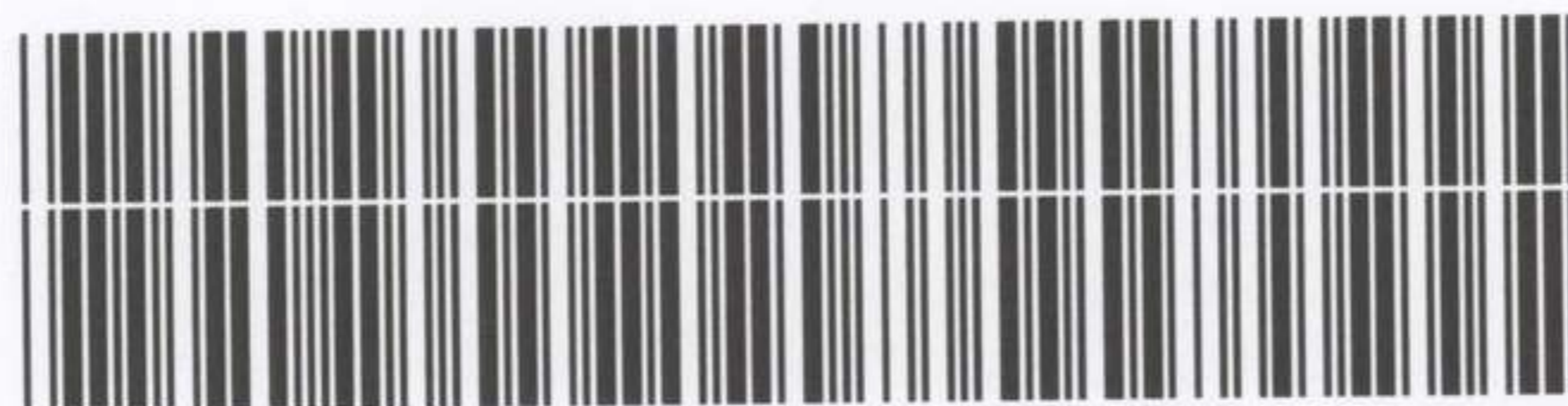

Evacuated to H.K. 20-11-18.</p> <p>St. Sgt. Hasson Admitted to 35 General 21-11-18.</p> <p>Leave Sgms Hamill granted 14 days to H.K.</p> <p>The Shaw " " " "</p> <p>Cpl Buttel " 10. " to Paris</p>
