

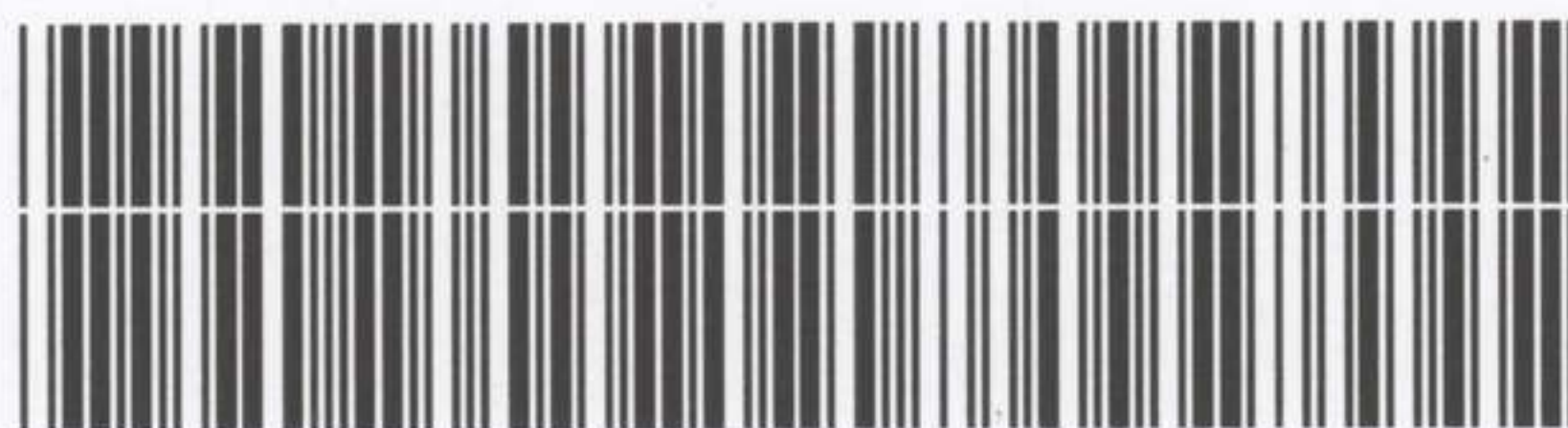

Fletre W. 12. a Map 27	30/11/15	9. a. m.	<p><u>Place</u> During the past month, from 1/11/15 to 30/11/15, the supply column under my command has been stationed at FLETRE, W. 12. a. Map 27. The lorries along the S. side of the Met-Baerda Road, & the W.S. along the God. Road. <u>Arrangement.</u> On 23/11/15, I moved the lorries into such a position that they lined one side of the road only.</p> <p><u>Sheds:</u> - Although necessary, sheds were secured for the lorries, while the W.S. sheds were used on a few occasions of the road, which proved excellent.</p> <p><u>Dump:</u> As reported last month, the Dump is at Busselboom, G 22 to Map 27. The column leaves the port at 5 a.m. daily, and arrives at the Dump via God., at 6.40 a.m.</p> <p><u>Railhead.</u> The Railhead is Baillend, which the Col. travels to from Dump, via Remunghelst, Westouke & Loue, arriving at 8.30 a.m.</p> <p>Health & Sanitation has been attended to in accordance with approved methods, particularly with regard to latrines, incineration of rubbish & bathing houses. During the past month, not a single member of the Unit has been admitted to hospital.</p> <p><u>Vehicle & equipment.</u> From the 1st to 29th inst., 148 M.T. & Vehicles, Cars, lorries & cycles, passed through my workshops for repairs of all desc.</p>
