

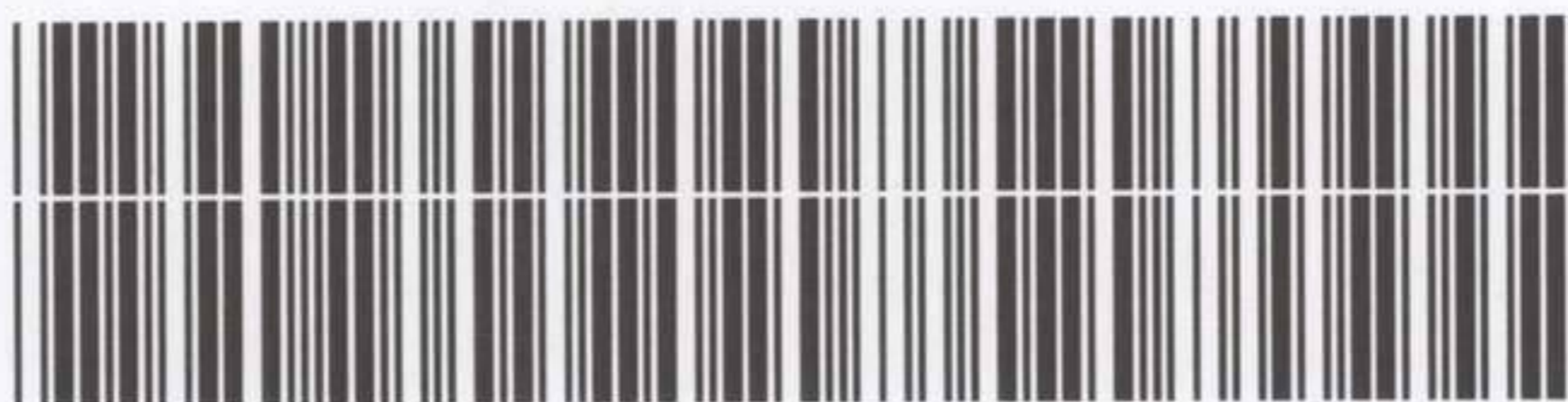

Captain.D.MacPherson O.C., 3rd Field Butchery A.I.F. separated from Unit by authority of Assistant Director of Supplies, Calais.

- 1/10/18. Bombardment of docks by 15inch guns.
9/10/18. S.S."BETWA" (case goods) arrived for Depot.
10/10/18. " "PRINCESS HELENA" (hay) arrived for Depot.
11/10/18. " "LANGLANDS" (case goods) arrived for Depot.
18/10/18. " "ALGAMA" (hay & straw) arrived for Depot.
20/10/18. " "PENLEE" (bulk oats) and S.S."GLASSALT" (case goods, hay & straw) arrived for Depot.
24/10/18. S.S."W.J.RADCLIFFE" (bulk oats) arrived for Depot.
27/10/18. " "YORK CASTLE" (case goods) arrived for Depot.
28/10/18. " "EDIE" (coal) arrived for Depot.
31/10/18. " "WAR MAJOR" (coal) and S.S."CLARISSA RADCLIFFE" (bulk oats) arrived for Depot.
