

WAR DIARY.

January 1918.

Captain.D.McPherson. O.C. 3rd Field Butchery.A.I.F. separated from unit by authority of A.D. of Supplies Calais.

6/1/18. Took over duties of 0 i/c Supplies, Dunkirk from Captain.A.S. Bonner.

7/1/18. Attack by enemy aircraft. S.S."Wimbrell" entered the port and was dealt with by the Depot, cargo 1539 bales Hay.

8/1/18. Took over depot cash from Captain.A.S.Bonner.

19/1/18. Attack by enemy aircraft. 21/1/18. Attack by enemy aircraft.

25/1/18.Attack by enemy aircraft. Bombardment of town by big gun (probably naval 17 inch.) 6 shots.

29/1/18. Attack by enemy aircraft. Lieut. J. Beavan. 14th A.D. U.S. left for 3rd Divisional Train.

30/1/18. Following ships entered the port and were dealt with by the Depot: - "Skeldon" 617 tons of steam coal. "Wimbrell"1122 bales Hay and 186 bales of straw.

Note. My unit at Calais and Vendroux during the month doing various forms of supply work.
