Captain.D.MacPherson O.C. 3rd Field Butchery A.I.F. separated from unit by authority of A.D.of Supplies, Calais.

- 5/3/18. "Ardenhall" entered port for the Depot (Hay) Also "Whimborne" (bulk oats.)  
7/3/18. 2 air-raid warnings.  
11/3/18. Air-raid warnings.  
12/3/18. Air-raid warnings.  
14/3/18. "Wabana" entered port for the Depot (condensed milk.)  
17/3/18. Air-raid warning.  
20/3/18. 2 air-raids and bombardment of town by enemy destroyers. "Skeldon" (coal) and "Watrefoil" (condensed milk) entered port for the Depot.  
21/3/18. Air-raid warning.  
22/3/18. Air-raid warning.  
23/3/18. Air-raid and bombardment with 15in guns from the line.  
24/3/18. Air-raid and bombardment by 15in gun from the line.  
25/3/18. Air-raid.  
26/3/18. Air-raid and bombardment by 15in gun from the line.  
27/3/18. "Poland" entered port for the Depot (Hay) Air-raid warning.  
30/3/18. "Telemachus" entered port for the Depot (Flour and oats.)  
31/3/18. "Albano" entered port for the Depot (Hay, straw, biscuits, and Grocery rations.)

Note. My unit at Calais and Vendroux doing general supply work.
