

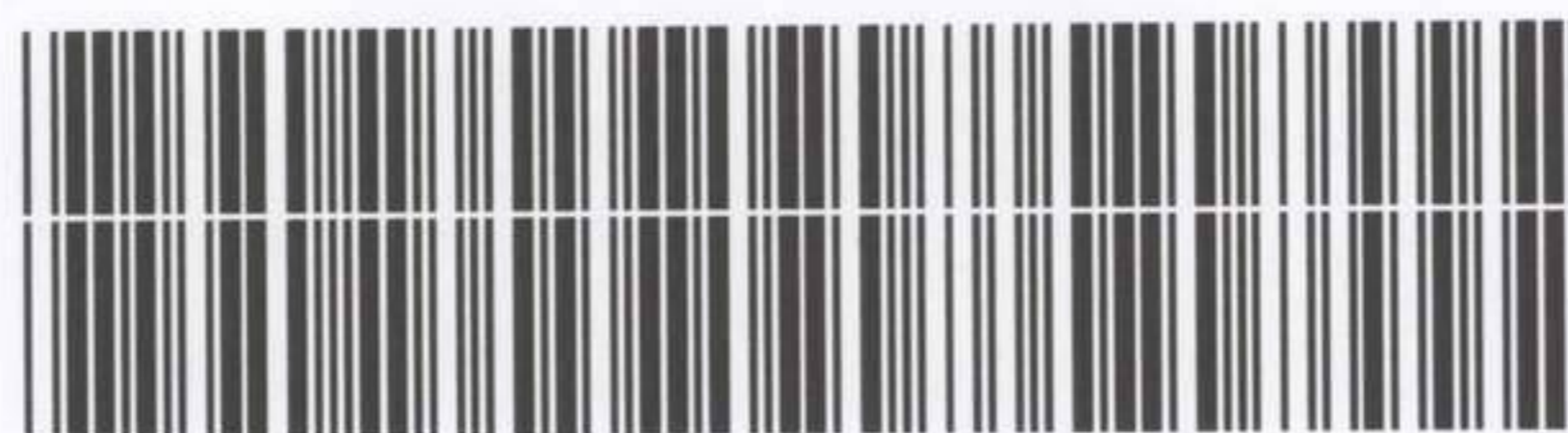

- 1/7/18. Air-raid.
- 2/7/18. "Antigone" (hay & straw) entered port for the Depot.
- 4/7/18. Air-raid.
- 6/7/18. "Knight Companion" (oats flour and oatmeal) entered port for the Depot.
- 7/7/18. Air-raid. "Crown of Toledo" (bulk oats) entered port for the Depot.
- 13/7/18. "Hartfield" (bulk oats) entered port for the Depot.
- 19/7/18. Air-raid.
- 21/7/18. "Cranley" (bulk oats pork & beans, flour) entered port for the Depot. Air-raid.
- 22/7/18. "Polglass Castle" entered port for the Depot.
- 23/7/18. "Wimborne" (bulk oats) entered port for the Depot.
- 25/7/18. Air-raid.
- 27/7/18. "Huntslyde" (hay & straw) entered port for the Depot.
