Company with 17 Tractors were attached on 10th September, 13 of which were placed as Supply Tractors and 4 for ammunition. The tractor for Supplies were used between JERICHO and advanced OBEIDEH dump, but proved unsatisfactory mainly owing to the bad state of the roads. OBEIDEH dump was cleared on 5th October and the tractor company were then used for Salvoing guns.</p> <p>On 17th September 20 lorries were attached from 3107 company, being distributed as follows:- 1 for Head Quar. Post, 1 for Canteens, 5 for Ammunition, 13 for Perishable Supplies from JERUSALEM to JERICHO.</p> <p>On 21st September 60 lorries from 10440 company reported at JERICHO, and worked between JERICHO and AMMAN with Supplies.</p> <p>About 29th September or further 25 lorries reported from 20th Corps, and transported Supplies from JERUSALEM to JERICHO. This made a total of 105 lorries available for the Force, and these lorries together with the workshops that came from JERUSALEM to JERICHO on 21st October came under Command of Captain HOWE, D. S. O. 10440 M.T. Company.
