1.MOVES.

No 32 and 33 Companies A.A.S.C.will leave present camp site at 0800 on November 5th.for KILO 295 as follows, carrying one days Supplies for Divisional Troops and 1st.A.L.H.Brigade, and two days Supplies for themselves.
