The train left at 0700, quite a large number of the inhabitants of the Village were at the Station and gave us a very enthusiastic send off. We arrived at Southampton Dock at 1005, were detrained and duly embarked on the Kaiser-I-Hind.

(4) MEDICAL

Recently a certain number of men with scabies or Pottoli (crabs) have been struck off Boat Rolls at the final Medical Examination before Embarkation. Pottoli can be rapidly removed and Scabies can be cured in five days, so that if these men had reported earlier they would have been cured in time to allow them to embark.

All ranks with any skin irritation who have any suspicion that they have any skin complaint, especially if they are likely to be placed early on Boat Rolls, should proceed to their Medical Officer for examination at the usual sick periods.

It is in any man's own interest to see that he is inoculated with Influenza Vaccine and that necessary entries are made in his Pay Book. If Pay Books are not available will be given a certificate of inoculation which will be signed by the Medical Officer.

Further, any cases of Gonorrhoea can be cured by early treatment if not reported early enough. It is, therefore, to the advantage of men to report for treatment immediately they notice any signs of discharge, because, by so doing they may be cured in sufficient time to allow them to embark with the remainder of their Quota.

2. MECHANICS FOR SERVICE WITH R.A.F. in RUSSIA.

The R.A.F. is desirous of obtaining Volunteer Mechanics for Service in that portion of the R.A.F. now employed in RUSSIA. It is understood that certain enquiries have been made at the AIR MINISTRY in connection by A.F.C. mechanics. Mechanics, while members of the A.F.C. cannot be employed on this Duty, but there will be no objection by the A.I.F. Authorities to the discharge in the United Kingdom of such members as so desire to allow them to re-enlist in the R.A.F. for just 1, 2, or three years service. The rates of Pay, Bonus and Separation Allowance can be seen by making application to the R.S.M.'s Office. Members of the A.F.C. would be enlisted in the R.A.F. in their present Rank. It is notified that other Ranks only are required - there are no vacancies for Flying-Officers. Personnel so enlisted will, at the expiration of their service, be repatriated to AUSTRALIA, if they so desire.

2. TREATMENT OF SYPHILIS.

1. Any A.I.F. Officer or soldier who has had Syphilis, and has had only one course of treatment (seven injections of Salvarsan and seven injections of mercury) will be advised to have a second course before embarkation for Australia. This advise will be brought under the notice of all ranks now in, or subsequently marching into Command.
2. The continuation course of treatment will be given not less than eight weeks after the termination of the first course.
3. All Officers or soldiers now or subsequently undergoing treatment for Syphilis who are discharged to Units, after having been given only one course of treatment, and who agree to take a second course, will be retained in their units, until the eight weeks referred to in para 2 have elapsed.
4. All who undergo a second course of treatment in accordance with the above will be transferred to the Convalescent Depot, Parkhouse, where they will be given a course of treatment consisting of :- 6 Intravenous injections of Nevars - Nobillon, 45 gramme (or its equivalent- at intervals of seven days. 6 Intraveniscular injections of Mercurial Cream at intervals of seven days alternately with the intravenous injections. This course of treatment will be given irrespective of the result of the Wasserman Tests.
5. Accurate information of Anti-Syphiletic Treatment showing dates and dosages will be given on A.F.BIVO for all soldiers treated.
6. No Officer or soldier who has agreed to the second course will be embarked for Australia until treatment as above described has been carried out.
7. The following certificate will be added to the Embarkation Certificate required by Special Demobilization Order No.43 of 24th December 1918 sub para 3. "I certify that the Anti-Syphiletic Treatment described in R.O. 7139 of 23/1/19 has been given to all soldiers agreeing to it, except the undermentioned soldiers, who have refused."
8. All ranks who have had Syphilis, will be strongly advised to make use of this treatment, and will be informed that by so doing they will incur no forfeiture of pay.
9. This order does not apply to reinforcements from Australia if they are required to proceed to France. Such men will not be retained in England for the purpose of receiving the second course of Anti-Syphiletic Treatment nor will it apply to soldiers whose names have been submitted for boat Roll (See A.I.F. Depot Orders No.7139 of 23/1/19)

Medical

Recently a certain number of men with scabies or Pediculi (Crabs) have been struck off Boat-rolls at the Final Medical Inspection Before Embarkation. Pediculi can be rapidly removed and Scabies can be cured in five days, so that if these men had reported earlier they would have been cured in time to allow them to embark. All ranks with any skin irritation or who have any suspicion that they have any skin complaint especially if they are likely to be placed early on boat rolls, should parade to their medical officer for examination at the usual sick Parades. It is also in any man's own interest to see that he is inoculated with Influenza Vaccine and that necessary entries are made in his Pay Book. If Pay Books are not available he will be given a certificate of Inoculation which will be signed by the Medical Officer. Further, many cases of Gonorrhoea can be cured by early treatment if men report early enough. It is also therefore to the advantage of men to report for treatment immediately they notice any signs of a discharge, because, by so doing, they may be cured in sufficient time to allow them to embark with the remainder of the quota. SYPHILLIS.

- (1) Any A.I.F. Officer or soldier who has had Syphillitis and has only had one course of Treatment (seven injections of Salvarsan and seven injections of Mercury) will be advised to have a second course before Embarkation to AUSTRALIA. This advice will be brought under the notice of all RANKS now in, or subsequently marching into Command.
- (2) The continuation course of treatment will be given not less than eight weeks after the termination of the first COURSE.
- (3) All Officers & Soldiers now or subsequently undergoing treatment for Syphillitis who are discharged to Units after having been given only one course of Treatment, and who agree to take a second course will be retained in their Units until the eight weeks referred to in Para. 2 have elapsed.
- (4) All who undergo a second course of treatment in accordance with the above, will be transferred to The Convalescent Training Depot, PARKHOUSE, where they will be given a course of treatment consisting of:- 6 Intravenous injections of Novars-Molillen, (.45 grammes or its equivalent) at intervals of seven days.
Intravenous injections of
XXX Mercurial Cream at intervals of seven days alternate with the Intravenous injections.
This course of treatment will be given irrespective of the result of the Wasserman Test.
- (5) Accurate information of Anti-Syphillytic Treatment showing dates and dosages will be given on A.F.B.178 for all soldiers treated.
- (6) No Officer or Soldier who has agreed to the second course will be embarked for AUSTRALIA until the treatment above described has been carried out.
- (7) The following Certificate will be added to the EMBARKATION CERTIFICATE required by special Demobilisation ORDER No 43 of 24th December 1918 sub-para 3. "I certify that the Anti-Syphillytic Treatment described in R.O. 7130 of 23/1318 has been carried out on all soldiers agreeing to it except the undermentioned soldiers who have refused".
- (8) All ranks who have had Syphillitis, will be strongly advised to make use of this treatment and will be informed that by so doing, they will incur no forfeiture of Pay.
- (9) This order does not apply to Reinforcements from AUSTRALIA if they are required to proceed to France. Such men will not be retained in England for the purpose of receiving the second Course of Anti-Syphillytic treatment nor will it apply to Soldiers whose names have been already been submitted for Boat-Rolls.

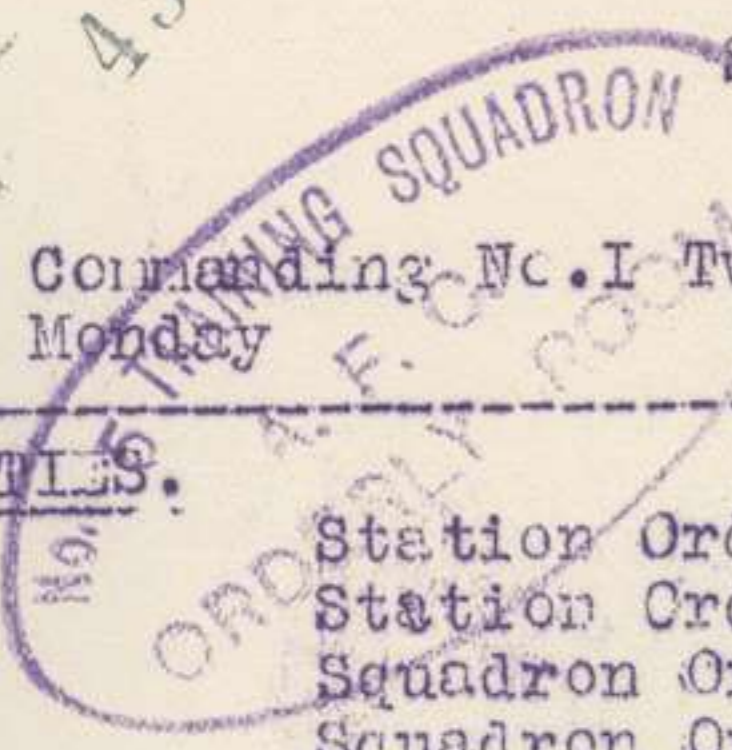

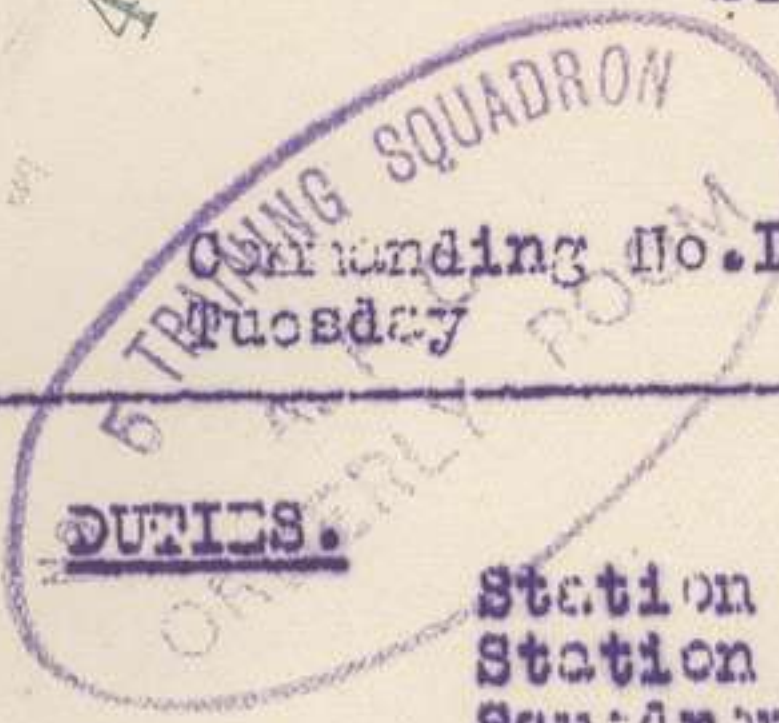

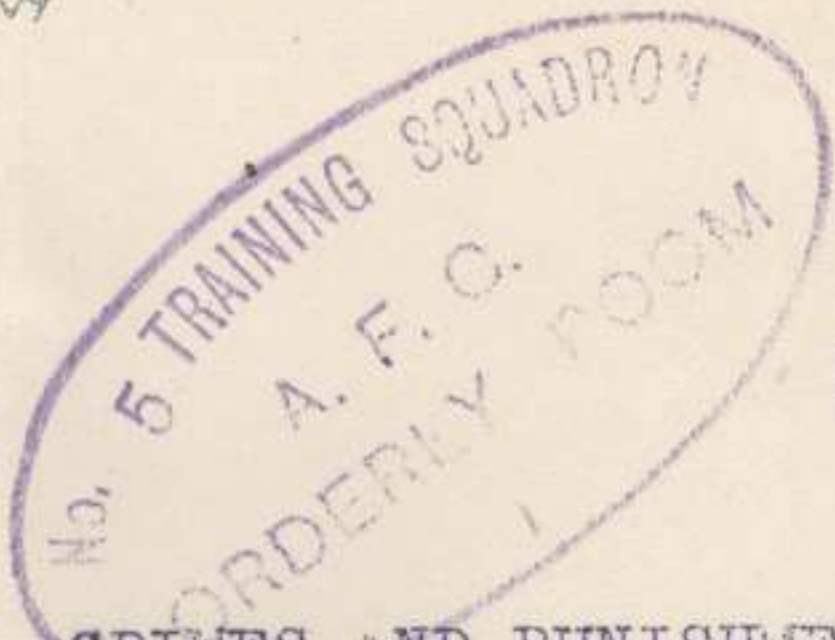
