

COURSE OF TRAINING IN AN ELEMENTARY TRAINING SQUADROn.

GROUND DUTIES. Before passing to Higher Training the following tests have to be passed.

1. WIRELESS, ARTILLERY & SIGNALLING. Six tests must be passed. Instruction is given daily classes of half and hour each by the Squadron Wireless Operators (N.C.O's or Air Mechanics) in the following subjects set out below. Examinations are held by the Wing Wireless Officer as pupils are reported ready by the Operators.

TESTS.

1. BUZZING. Six words per minute sending & receiving - Test three minutes duration.

- 2. ARTILLERY CODE. Written examination of six questions "Passed" = 80% correct.
- 3. ARTILLERY PICTURE TARGET. Ranging three targets correctly, sending their map coordinates and using Artillery Code & ground signals without error.
- 4. PANNEAU SIGNALLING. Reading miniature Panneau accurately from distance of 100 yards at rate of four words per minute.
- 5. SENDING ON SILENCED KEY. Clearly readable tape record at rate of six words per minute.
- 6. AIR TRAINING. Five times fully let out & wind up Aerial from Aeroplane in flight.

For "3" a model of country is made to correspond with the map to be used and is fitted with a number of small electric lights operated by switches by the Instructor. The flashes of the electric lights, represent shell bursts and the pupil is given a target and instructed to send by buzzer the Artillery correction for each flash as he sees it. The Instructor communicates with him by means of small strips of paper laid out to represent ground signals in the Artillery Code.



2 GUNNERY.

Five tests in the Lewis Gun & 3 in the Vickers must be passed.

The Elementary tests consist of stripping and study of mechanism and the pupil receives two hours instruction daily from the Squadron Armourer (Sergt or Corp) or Assistant Armourer (air mechanics). He is examined by the Wing Gunnery Officer and must obtain 75% marks in all tests.

FLYING.

Before passing on for higher training the pupil must fly for a total of four hours solo on the aeroplane in use for elementary training, usually Maurice Farman (Short Horn) or DeHaviland 6. The procedure is for the Instructor to accompany the pupil in the Aeroplane (which is always fitted with dual control) until the pupil can fly quite satisfactorily without any intervention on the parts of the instructor. This takes on an average. 32 hours made up in flights of from 20 to 30 minutes each.
