

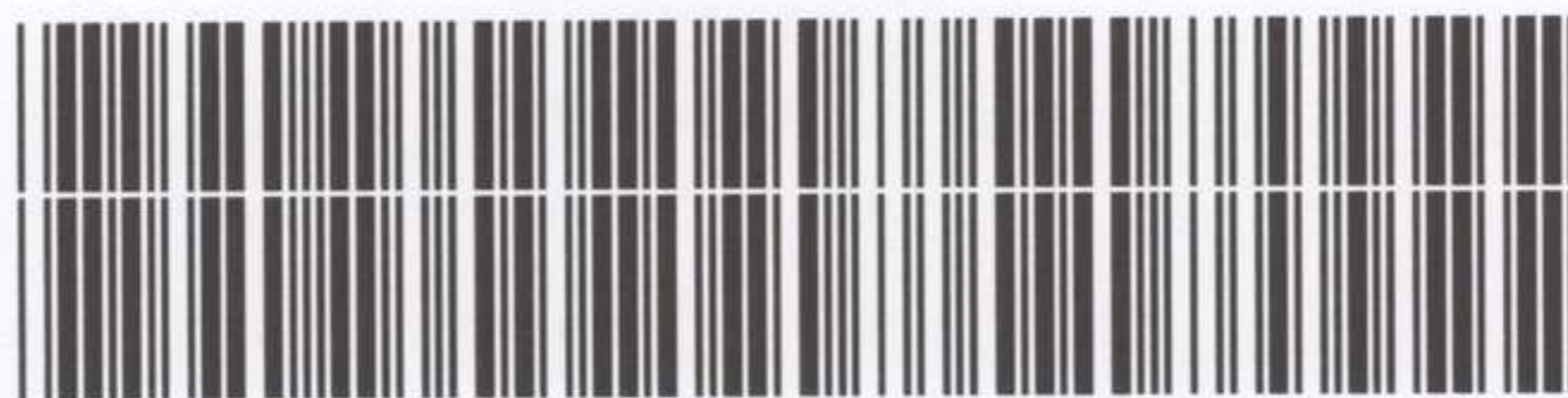

The strength of the Unit on 1st March comprised one
Officer and 25 other ranks. The work carried on being the
same as enumerated in previous diary, viz checking and
assisting with stores. On 11th Sgt Nash Henderson, Healy,
Cpl Zulayson, Ptes Fraser, Mailland & Warren, marched out
to Aust Base Depot for repatriation to Australia
whilst Pte Pantoll was demobilised in England whilst on
leave.
