

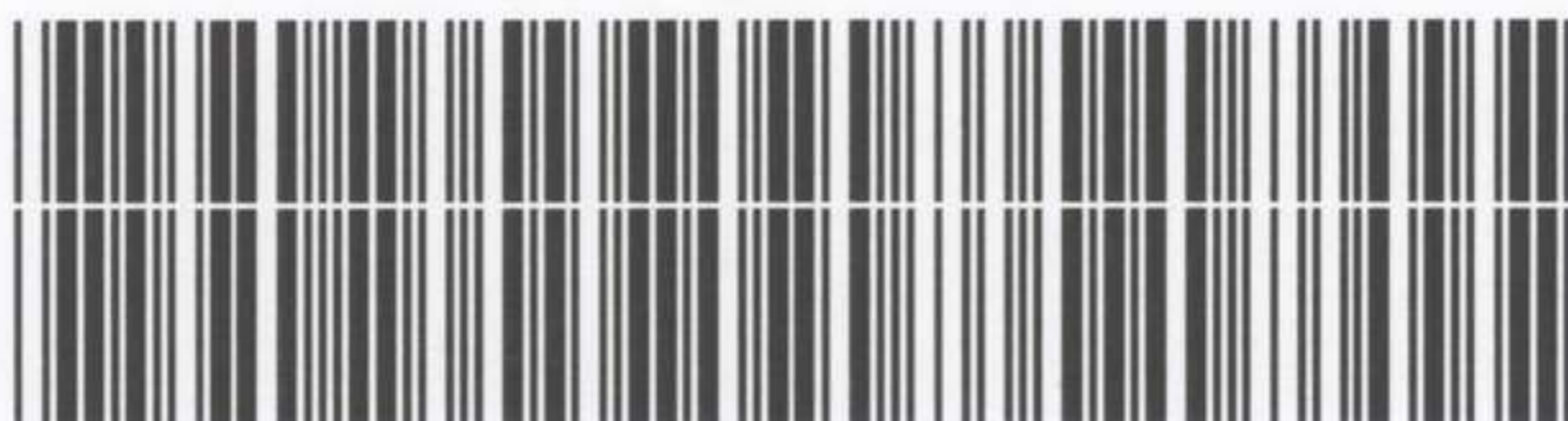

No 4 BSD APO S/8	1 <sup>st</sup> to 30 <sup>th</sup> APRIL 1918		<p>In submitting the Diary for the month of APRIL for the above unit, I request please that you accept same in it's usual brief condition.</p> <p>The work of the unit for the month being general supply work in Bulk, which work by reason of absence of adverse reports, I assume has been carried out by the unit in a satisfactory manner.</p> <p>The only effect, felt at this station, in connection with the stirring times of the month being an appreciable increase in receipt and output, which effect, in no way however, was permitted to cause disorganization, the increase being met and attended to in the usual quiet and orderly manner.</p> <p>The health of the unit was first class, no sick parades recorded.</p> <p>The discipline of the unit was for the month first class also.</p> <p>The rations &amp; quarters of the unit were and are excellent</p> <p>The weather, which is a minor factor on this station, as it never interferes with the work, was alternately wet and fine for the month.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">Maurice Capt 4<sup>th</sup> Just Field Butchery</p>
