

I regret to report that, at about 12.30 P.M. on 13-12-17, while unloading one of my Supply Lorries at 45th Battery, 12th A.B. Aust. F.A. (Sheet 28.8.30.c.) one of the drivers of the lorry picked up a "dud" German air bomb, which was lying in a small salvage dump alongside the duckwalk, and after examining it, dropped it, when it instantly exploded killing both drivers and three Artillerymen outright, and wounding six others, of whom two have subsequently died of wounds.

Attached is a certified true copy of the evidence of the only living witness of the accident.

Lorry No.36021 which was standing on the roadside about 15 feet away was practically undamaged, one small piece of bomb holing the radiator right near the top, and two pieces penetrating both sides of the wooden bodywork.

The funeral was held at 3 P.M., 14-12-17, when all the victims were interred together in STEENWERCHE Cemetry.

A/Bdr.Perry.E.J. No.4959 states :-

On the 13th instant about 12.20 P.M. when standing near the Cook house at Capper Lines, I saw a Motor Transport Driver handling a "dud" bomb which was lying near the salvage dump. I saw him turn it over in his hand, and was just calling out to him not to fool with it, when the explosion occurred.

Twelve men were hit, 6 of whom have since died of wounds.



#### NO. 1. AUSTRALIAN AMMUNITION SUB-PARK.

FROST PRECAUTIONS. The extremely cold weather during last winter was responsible for many casualties, (Such as cracked cylinders, etc,) in the M. T. and the experience goes to show the extreme need of great care being taken to prevent a reoccurence of the same casualties during the ensuing winter:-

(1) At present a 20% mixture of Methylated Spirkt must at all times be main tained in the radiators of all lorries on charge or attached to this Unit.

Later on the mixture will be increased to 55%

(2) Lorry drivers will always carry on the lorry at least one gallon to spare of Methylated Spirit.

(3) If a lorry is being sent on detachment away from the Unit, this amount

will be increased to two gallons to spare.

(4) Bonnet covers will always be fitted immediately a lorry pulls up, and at all times when standing in Camp, or Parking place.

(5) Radiators and Cylinders will, until further notice, be drained nightly. The water will be put into receptacles and kept for use when required. After emptying the radiators the plug will be left out, this is necessary toensure proper drainage.

(6) When making short halts in cold weather drivers must exercise care to AXE prevent their water circulation freezing. The engines will be run for

five minutes every thirty minutes under these circumstances.

(7) All drivers are warned that in the event of a breakdown on the road during frosty weather, they must take the necessary precautions to prevent the water in the engines freezing. The engine must be frequently run, or in the event of an engine breakdown, such as magneto trouble, etc, the water must be emptied out at once while the engine is hot.

(8) When lorries are awaiting or undergoing repairs, or overhaul in the workshop, the water will at all times be emptied from the radiators,

and the water conserved for further use.

(9) Special attention should be paid that water or rain does not collect in the dismantled cylinders or radiators whilst in the store, or awaiting

repairs.

(10)N.C.O's on duty or in charge of lorries at any time will be equally responsible to see that the above regulations are carefully observed. Too much importance cannot be placed on the strict observance of the orders in detail.

(11) The N. C. C. on duty each night in the workshops will be responsible that the radiators and cylinders of all lorries on the workshop standings are emptied, and that Bonnet Covers are correctly fitted. assure the Orderly N. C. O. of the day that all is correct upon

completion of same.

(12) The Orderly N. C. O. of the day will render a certificate to the Orderly Officer at 9-0 P.M. nightly, to the effect that he has personally dupervised the emptying of radiators and cylinders, and the fitting of Bonnet covers of the lorries of this Unit, and of the lorries attached to this Unit. He will also state that the N. C.Co. on duty in the workshops has assured him of all being correct on the workshop standings.

N.B. When radiators are emptied, the water from them must be conserved and used for filling later. By this means the ensued percentage of

Methylated Spirits will not be wasted.
