Summary of Important Events of the Month -----January 1918.

The month has been very quiet, the daily expenditure of ammunition shows that no operations took place on the Corps Front.

The Sub Parks were all, with the exception of No.5 in the Divisional Rest Area, busy overhauling their lorries in preparation for a spell of continuous hard work later in the year.

In accordance with the Policy of the Army, Sports, Concerts and Cinemas were organised to keep the men interested and healthy.

On the 4th three American Officers came along to study the working of the M.T. in the Corps and were shown round during the ensuing week.

No.57 A.S.P. came under control of this office on the 2nd for a couple of days, pending re-adjustment of the Army Area, They then marched out to XV Corps.

On the 12th, owing to the extension of the Corps Area to the North, No.4 Aust.A.S.P. came into the Corps. As they had had a busy time in the South and their lorries were badly in need of an overhaul they were allowed to remain in their camp, which has an excellent workshop standing and used as little as possible to enable them to concentrate on the repair of their lorries.

On the 15th about 8.O.P.M., there was a heavy fall of rain, which flooded out the Corps Reserve and ruined, by damp, most of the fireworks there.

From midnight 15/16th till midnight 21/22nd Thaw Precautions were in force and all lorry traffic suspended, except for urgent cases for which Army Authority had to be obtained.

On the 26th The C.I.M.T. Inspectors visited Nos 1 and 2 Aust.A.S.P. & 3rd and 6th A.B.Aust.F.A.Park Sections and expressed themselves as satisfied with the condition of the vehicles.


At the end of the month arrangements were made for Nos 2 and 5 Sub Parks to change places, on the move of the 2nd Australian Division ~~from~~ to, and the 5th Australian Division from, the Rest Area.

Captain Cleveland M.C. Artillery Officer reported back from leave on the 5th and the Adjutant and Demands Officer, Lieut's Lane and Isles were on leave from the 11th to the 25th.

To complete information asked for by Administrative Headquarters A.I.F. the D.M.T.S., A.I.F. called for particulars of every vehicle that had been on charge to the Australian Ammunition M.T.Units in France. This entailed a considerable amount of clerical work, Copies of the return furnished are attached as Appendix 3.
