

RE-ORGANISATION OF M.T. UNITS.

NOTES AS TO HOMOGENEITY AND STANDARDISATION OF TYPES (Issued with
Director of Transports 15165/5 dated 3rd March 1918).

It is desirable when carrying out this re-organisation to ensure that any lorries of non-standard types, now allotted to Field Units, should be among the vehicles due for return on becoming surplus.

In order to make it quite clear which types are considered non-standard, a list is given below.

It should be noted however, that certain lorries which are allotted for technical purposes must be retained even though these particular types appear in the list below. As examples :-

6712 (Q.A.1.)

1. In continuation of my 6712 (Q.A.1.) of 27-9-17, it has been decided, in accordance with War Office letter 121/France/1215 (S.D.2.) of 13-2-18, to extend the system of pooling Mechanical Transport which has already been inaugurated by the formation of G.H.Q. Reserve M.T. Companies out of the (late) G.H.Q. Ammunition Parks, supplemented by lorries withdrawn from Siege Batteries.

2. The following measures of reorganisation will be adopted with effect from March 12th. The new designations of units, as notified below, will take effect from midnight, March 12/13th.

- (a) The existing H.Q. Corps Supply Column and H.Q. Corps Ammunition Park will be abolished as such, and from them will be formed a H.Q. Corps M.T. Column on the establishment given in appendix "A". The future designation of these H.Q. and the Officers appointed to command them are as shown in appendix.1.
- (b) Existing Divisional Supply Columns and Ammunition Sub Parks will be amalgamated and reformed into Divisional M.T. Companies on the establishment given in Appendix. "B". The consequent changes in Units' designations are as shown in Appendix.2.
- (c) Existing Corps Troops Supply Column will be expanded to the establishment given in Appendix "C", and will in future be designated Corps Troops M.T. Companies. The consequent changes in Units' designations are as shown in Appendix.
- (d) Existing Army Troops Supply Columns and Auxiliary Petrol Companies allotted to Armies for carriage of blankets will be amalgamated and reformed into Army Troops M.T. Companies on the establishment given in Appendix. "D". The consequent changes in Units' designations are as shown in Appendix 4.
- (e) Existing Cavalry Supply Columns, and the Ammunition carrying lorries of (late) Cavalry Divisional Ammunition Parks, will be amalgamated and reformed into Cavalry Divisional M.T. Companies on the establishment given in Appendix "E". The consequent changes in Units' designations are as shown in Appendix 2. This reorganisation will only apply to 1st and 2nd and 3rd Cavalry Divisions.
- (f) The Cavalry Corps Troops Supply Column will be expanded to the establishment given in Appendix "F", and will in future be designated a Cavalry Corps Troops M.T. Coy. (vide Appendix 3).
- (g) In addition to the above, certain changes will be made in the M.T. Companies now allotted to G.H.Q. Troops. These will be communicated in a separate paper.
- (h) Separate instructions will be issued as to the Officers appointed to command Army Troops, Corps Troops and Divisional M.T. Companies.

3. --- As a result of the pools of transport provided under para 2 a reduction will be made in the M.T. Vehicles now borne on the establishment of certain Units. These reductions are shown in Appendix 5 and the vehicles and personnel thus released will be utilized either for the changes in establishment effected under paras 2 and 4 or treated as surplus as indicated in para 7.

4. The personnel and vehicles of Army F.A. Park Sections will be increased from that now admissible under W.E.501/101 to that shown in the establishment contained in Appendix "G". The additional officers required under the latter establishment will be posted to Armies as early as possible.

5. In order to regularise the withdrawal of lorries from Siege Battery Ammunition Columns, carried out under my 6636 (Q.A.1.) of 10-9-17. (To First, Third and Fourth Armies) and of 19-12-17 (to Second and Fifth Armies), and referred to in para 1 above, new transport establishments for Battery Ammunition Columns concerned have been prepared and are contained in Appendixes "H" to "M"

6. Box Motor Cars have been included in the establishment of H.Q. of the new M.T. Companies but owing to difficulties of production the numbers required to complete the new establishment of Units will not be forthcoming for some time. Until they are available, one 3-ton Lorry may be retained as additional to establishment and will be driven by the drivers allowed in the establishment for Box Cars.

7. On the new establishment now circulated becoming operative, a considerable number of M.T. Vehicles will be withdrawn from service and will become surplus. To cope with such surplus vehicles, during the period intervening between their withdrawal and the issue of D. Transport of instructions as to their disposal, Armies will arrange for the formation of temporary "Vehicle Reception Parks". In order to provide a nucleus Staff for these Parks, which it is estimated ~~for a period~~ will be required for a period of about three weeks, the completion of the amalgamation referred to in para 2 (d) will be deferred with a view to the present H.Q. Army Auxiliary (Petrol) Companies being made available to act as the Headquarters of the Temporary Vehicle Reception Parks. Arrangements will be made to post, as a temporary measure, four A.S.C. Officers (M.T.) to each Army, for attachment to the Army Auxiliary Petrol Company until the dispersal of the vehicles in the Reception Parks has been completed.

8. As this reorganisation legislates for a considerable saving of personnel, all possible adjustments of surplus and deficient personnel will be effected within Armies, so as to avoid any calls being made on the Base for reinforcements. Surplus vehicles for evacuation under para 7 will be evacuated to Vehicle Reception Park with a crew of one driver per vehicle and one spare driver for every 4 vehicles; surplus workshop lorries complete with their crew of Artificers. Any personnel remaining surplus to the new establishments, after surplus vehicles have been withdrawn, and after all possible adjustments of personnel between units have been effected within Armies will be evacuated to No. 1 Base M.T. Depot ROUEN.

9. In the case of Units broken up under the provision of Appendix 1, 2 and 4, essential records, such as vehicle and personnel registers, etc. will be transferred to the Units into which those noted for breaking up are merged. Other documents, records and accounts, will be balanced, closed, and forwarded to the A.G.'s Office at the Base for custody.

10. Detailed instructions as to the method under which vehicles and personnel are to be accounted for, will be issued by the Director of Transport to his representatives with Armies, who will also receive from the Director of Transport instructions as to the eventual disposal of the surplus vehicles withdrawn under para 7.

11. Armies will report to this Office the date of completion of this reorganisation.

Appendix 6

Summary of Important Events of the month.

The most, and practically the only, important event of this month was the Re-organisation of the M.T. resulting in the abolition of the Ammunition Park and Supply Column Headquarters and the formation of Divisional M.T. Companies under a H.Q. Corps M.T.

Advantage was taken of this to, as far as possible, homogenise the makes of the lorries in the various Units. See Appendix 3.

All correspondence, records etc were gone through, all important matter over three months old was sent to War Records London.

The Ammunition Expenditure was normal throughout this period.

At about 11.0.A.M. on the 12th four enemy shells arrived in BAILLEUL and exploded near the ARMENTIERES Road exit from the Square.
