

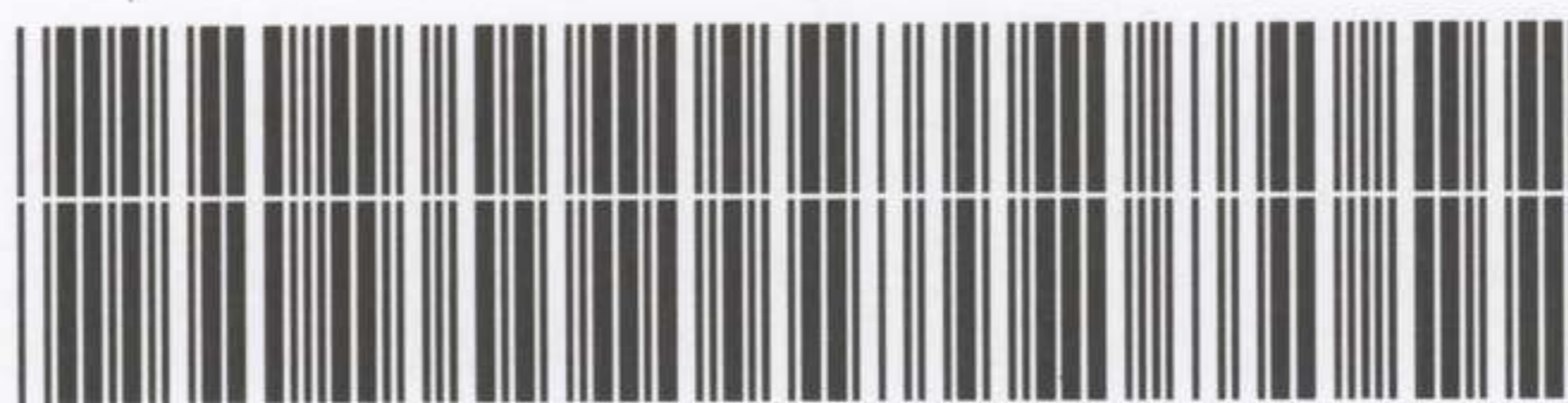

Gailly	19.18		Located at Gailly-sur-Somme. Evacuations to 1st Aust V.E.S. at Corbie.	
Halle	29.18		Marched out from Gailly to Halle near Peronne.	
"	9.9.18		All men in the Section ill through drinking poisoned shell hole water; 12 sent to C.C.S., including Capt Luky R.A.V.C.. All except 4 returned direct to unit within a few days.	
"	12.9.18		An advanced collecting post of 1 Sgt and 2 men established near Buire.	
"	18.9.18		a second and more advanced post established at Roisel. This also consisted of 1 Sgt and 2 men.	
			Animals collected at the Roisel post were sent in the early morning to the post at Buire. In the afternoon all animals received at Buire were sent to the main section at Halle. They rested there for 1 night and the following day were sent on to the 1st Aust V.E.S. near Bray.	
"	24.9.18		Both advanced posts recalled to Halle.	
Fouilloy	25.9.18		Section marched to Fouilloy (Corbie).	
Vignacourt	26.9.18		Marched to Vignacourt.
