

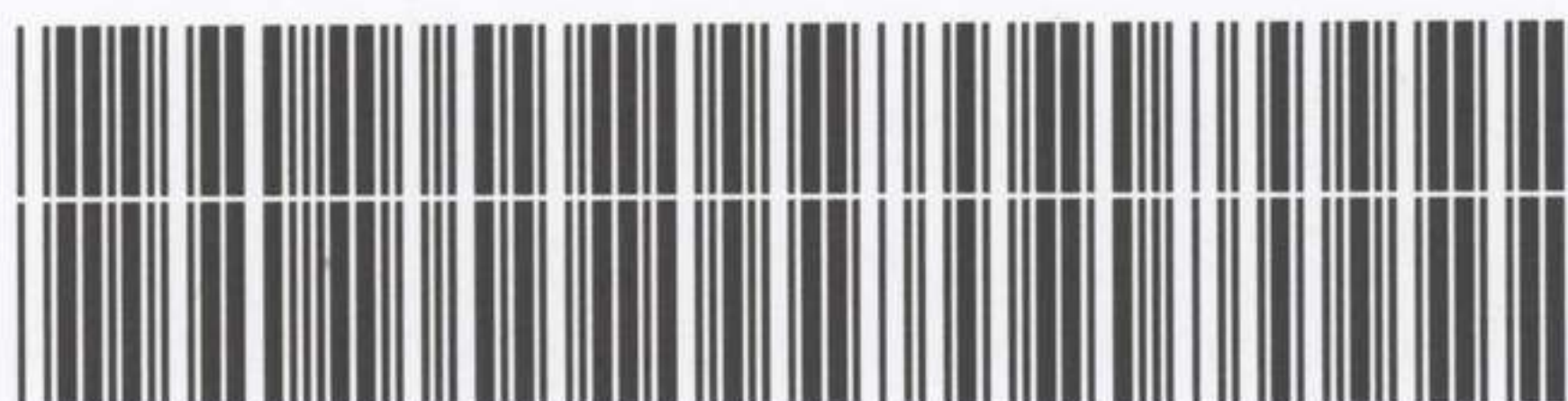

Summary of Events and Information

During the month of November Unit remained located at ALLERY (see Map ABBEVILLE)

Work of evacuations was reduced to a minimum owing to the Military situation of the Division.

The usual routine work of the Unit only was carried out. All Equipment was brought up to War Establishments. Vehicles overhauled and painted. Beyond the necessary attention to animals daily, men were allowed the rest of the time to themselves.

Rations and water supply for animals, during the month were good.

The general condition of animals passing through the M.V.S to the Base was not of a high standard; many being in poor condition.
