Piquendal	1st - 12th		During the first twelve days of the month the unit was camped at Piquendal near Jacquembourg. We remained in rest. Evacuations and treatment of animals was almost nil. The time was used in giving the men a little elementary drill and exercise. Gas drill was practised daily.	
	12th		Unit moved from Piquendal at 9 am and travelled by road to billets just outside the town of Boeseghem Travelling via Onve-Werquin and the town of Aise.	
	13th		Moved from Boeseghem to Yunic Bequin.	
	14th		Remained at Yunic Bequin	
	15th		Moved from Yunic Bequin to new billet in mill at Bsd. 5.7 Skat 36A near the town of Nieppe.	
			The billet occupied till the end of the month has very good accommodation for a mobile Veterinary Section the stable being in good order. Several small improvements were added by us however.	
			Evacuations from 15th till end of the month were not heavy the horse in the division not feeling the winter nearly so much as last year when the majority were on open standings. Very little mange being evacuated what is is not all from one or two divisions. This is probably partly due to the clipping having been got through fairly early.
