

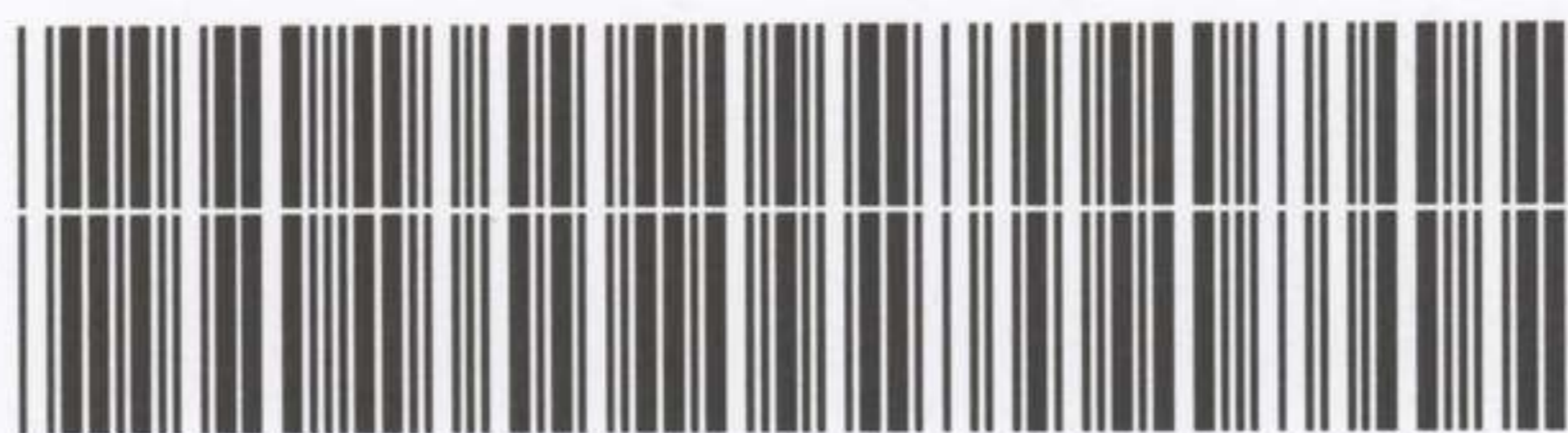

	24-10-16		Handed over 52 animals (including 12 mules) to 52nd M.V.S.	
	24-10-16	1-30 PM	Marched out to Steenvoorde arriving at 4 PM. Very poor accommodation, Wet trip. Field for horses very wet & muddy	
	24-10-16		No 262 Sgt LEWERS S. went on leave to BELFAST	
STEENVOORDE	26-10-16	7-45 AM	Marched out to CAESTRE entrained at 8-30 AM. Left at H. 33 AM. Very cold trip, Detained at PONTREMY 9-30 to 11-30 PM. Marched to FRANCIÈRES arrived 1-45 AM (27-10-16). Camped in open, very cold & wet. Black horse, one of float team, had Colic.
