During the month the health of the animals in the Division, remained good.

During the period the Mobile was at "Bussy" 86 animals were received from the Artillery, these were mainly Culls, that the Artillery had not been able to get rid of, owing to their absence from Division.

From Bussy to Ermut the Mobile moved in one day, and while at Ermut received the usual number of minor cases. From Ermut to Loch Le Chateau the journey was done in one day, and the Mobile was fixed in good but very filthy Bunkies & Stables, the cleaning of which was completed by the end of the year.
