

The move back was carried by stages as follows, Amman to Shunet Mimrin thence to Jericho to Talat ed Dum, to jerusalem, to Latronand finally to Wadi Hanein-Richon camping areas.  The 1st A.L.H.Bde and 20th Infantry Bde together with D.H.Q. remain at Amman and the 6th Joh Wet Section remain at Jerichoto receive sick animals from units at mman.

AUSTRALIAN AND NEW ZEALAND MOUNTED DIVISION.

As instructed I proceeded to LUDD on the 21st inst and inspected the horses of the 2nd A.L.H. and New Wealand Bdes on the 22-10-18. 1 also inspected the horses of the 18th R.W.A.Bde. on the 23-10-18.

The horses of the 2nd A.L.H. Bde with few exveptions are in a very good condition and are fit for any work. Those of the New Zealand M.R. Bde are not as fat but are generally in fair condition and are inproving rapidly every day.

The 18th R.H.A.Bde has just received 100 good remounts and the horses have done exceptionally well particularly those of the ammunition column.

The horses generally of this Bde are in much better condition now than before the recent operations and they are thriving a rapidly.

All the animals in the area are getting are a good ration and are doing well , but it is considered that if they are likely to remain in the area for any period , that a small krall be eredted for each brigade to treat the worst eases conditioned animals in .

Shoeing is going on as quickly as possible but there is a great shortage of smiths owing to sickness.
