

- AUGUST 1st 1918. 12 L.D. horses marched out to A.&N.Z.T.C.&D.C. on loan. *JH*
- " 2nd 72 Pack mules marched out to Remount Depot, Kantara. *JH*  
Lt-Col. Nicholas A.D.V.S. Palestine I. of C. inspected a number of horses in the Depot suffering from dermatitis and advised washing with a disinfectant, and plenty of grooming. *JH*
- " 3rd. 18 Aust. horses marched in from 16th Veterinary Hospital. *JH*
- " 5th. Capt. Elphick New Zealand Vet. Corps, Lieut Colly, 2nd Lieut Dobbins and 2/Lieut Brown of the Indian Army marched in this day and are attached for rations. *JH*
- " 8th. Brig. General C.L. Bates C.B., C.M.G., D.S.O. inspected the Depot today. *JH*
- " 11th. 211 mules marched out to No 1 Remount ~~Remount~~ Section Ludd, Capt. P.D. Bright in charge. *JH*
- " 14th 25 horses (Cobs) marched out to No 1 Remount Depot Kantara. *JH*
- " 20th. Lieut Solly, 2nd Lieut Dobbins and 2nd Lieut Brown (Indian Army) marched out this day. *JH*
- " 21st. 180 horses and 28 mules marched out this day to No 1 Field Remount Section Ludd. Capt. H.S. Tyndall in charge. *JH*
- " 25th. 110 horses (rides) and 25 P.B. rides marched out to No 1 Remount Depot. *JH*
- " 28th. Capt. Elphick New Zealand Vet. Corps marched out this day. *JH*
- " 29th 30 horses marched in from 16th Veterinary Hospital. *JH*
- " 30th. Col. D.McLeish. C.M.G..V.D. proceeded to Rest Camp Port Said, during his absence Major A.B. Paterson will act as Commandant. *JH*
- SEPTEMBER 1918.
- " 4th. 6 P.B. horses and 6 P.B. mules marched out to A.&N.Z.T.C.&D.V. Moascar. *JH*
- " 9th. 139 horses and 11 mules, 16 P.B. horses marched out this day to No 1 Remount Depot enroute to Ludd. Lieut N.C. Brown in charge with 30 O/Rks they are to stay at Ludd until further notice. *JH*



SEPTEMBER 1918

- 10th. Colonel D. McLeish, C.M.G..V.D. returned from Rest Camp Port Said and resumed command of the Depot. *JH*
- 11th Major H.W. Smith and 25 O/Rks proceeded to Remount Depot Belbeis to bring back horses. *JH*
- 14th 31 horses marched in from 16th Veterinary Hospital, Kantara. *JH*
- 15th. Capt. H.S. Tyndall and 30 O/Rks marched out to No 1 Field Remount Section Ludd, for duty. *JH*
- 16th Major A.B. Paterson, Lieut T.F. Little and 62 O/Rks marched out to Field Remount Section, Ludd for duty. *JH*
- 17th Colonel D. McLeish C.M.G..V.D. marched out to 26th Stationary Hospital Ismailia. *JH*
- 18th Lieut T.F. Little marched in from Field Remount Section Ludd. *JH*
- 20th. 33 horses marched in from 16th Veterinary Hospital Kantara. Capt. P.D. Bright marched out to A.I.F. Headquarters on duty. *JH*
- 21st. 4 horses marched out to Northern Wagon Wireless Sect. *JH*
- 22nd. 42 O/Rks marched out to No 1 Field Remount Sect. for duty. *JH*
- 24th ~~22nd.~~ Capt. P.D. Bright marched in from A.I.F. Hdqrs. *JH*
- 26th. Major Paterson marched in from No 1 Field Remount Sect. Ludd. *JH*
- 30th. 10 P.B. riding horses marched out to A.&.N.Z.T.C.&.D.C. *JH*
