



Arrangements were made for all applications for Discharge outside Australia, Extended Leave, &c., submitted after the 15th December, to be dealt with by the A.A.G.'s Branch, A.I.F.Headquarters.  A Cadre of 2 Officers and 9 Other ranks will remain on duty as from 1st January, 1920, to finalise all cases received up to 15th December and to deal with N.M.E. personnel who complete their courses at the end of this year.  The remainder of the Staff will then be available for repatriation at the expiration of their Staff Leave, and the Branch will cease to function as from the 31st December, 1919.  The London Area ceased to function on the 29th December, and all outstanding cases of personnel on N.M.E. were handed over to 1.D.1. on that date.
