Normal routine work has mainly engaged this Branch during the past week.

Matters of importance dealt with are as follows :-

Harness and Saddlery:

Issue Vouchers from Woolwich Depot continue to shew particulars of pattern 1902 Saddlery which it is proposed to issue in satisfaction of our Demands. Letter was therefore addressed to The Secretary, War Office, referring to War Office letter of 26.6.19 and the undertaking to supply articles of latest pattern only, - pointing out the existing difficulty at Woolwich, where officials appear to know nothing of the above arrangement. Copies of letters attached.

Reply to our letter to Woolwich on this matter, dated 20.2.20, was received, and copy is attached.

In accordance with Cable No.WK/482 of 17th inst., received from Department of Defence, Melbourne, four copies of each of the undermentioned documents were forwarded to Australia, referring to sets of Harness, Saddlery, and Packsaddlery demanded for the re-equipment of the A.I.F.

Sir,
With further reference to this Office letter number 21912 dated the 9th May 1919, relative to the supply of latest pattern articles for the Post Bellum Army of Australia, I have now been directed to inform you that we have had to refuse several obsolete items, particularly in regard to Harness and Saddlery.

On representing the matter to Officials at the Arsenal and Dockyard they aver they have never seen any directions that latest patterns are to be issued. Please see War Office 121/Overseas/6759 (Q.M.G.10A) of 26.6.19 (Copy attached.)

One item in particular has been constantly brought to my notice i.e. "Pattern 1902 Saddles" (Saddlery, Universal) and a request has already been despatched to D.D.O.S. Woolwich, asking that only the Pattern 1912 adjustable Saddle be issued, as the use of the 1902 pattern has long been discontinued in Australia.

I should be very glad if the necessary instructions could be issued to Depots concerned, please.
