France	1.6.18 to 30.6.18		<p><u>Location:</u> Up to the 15th inst., the section was located on the querrieu - Amiens road. On that date a move was made to a new location close to the village of ST GRATIEN.</p> <p><u>General work of the month:</u> walls for protection against bombs were erected round the horse lines, and spare time occupied in getting transport vehicles painted and harness repaired.</p> <p><u>Evacuation of animals:</u> The number of animals evacuated was lower than for some considerable time past viz: 134 Horses and 44 Mules Total 168.</p> <p>There is nothing of special importance to note on the month's operations.</p> <p><u>Honours and awards:</u> Extract from London Gazette, Supplement No 30750 dated 17th June 1918.</p> <p>Meritorious service Medal awarded to No 175 sgt W.C.Pentland, A.A.VG 5th Aust Mob Vet section.</p> <p style="text-align: right;"><i>Ross Grant</i> Capt.,</p>
