





RE FURTHER AMALGAMATION OF UNITS. -

1. It is at no time my intention to destroy the identity of the various Units as they pass under my command. Until the end each Unit will retain its own Officers and Non-Commissioned Officers.
2. This will apply even should a Battalion be reduced to a Platoon, or even less. It will still remain an independent Unit, answerable only to the Central Office, which will remain under my command. The only exception to this rule will be the Transport, which it is recognised must be a mixed Unit, so far as personnel is concerned. As this is designed to expedite the final rapid Demobilisation of the men, I feel certain that neither the personnel of the 9th, nor that of the 10th, who will be then amalgamated into a composite Unit, will do anything but give their complete support and loyalty to the Officer who for the time being may be placed at their head.
3. After the departure of the next draft to Australia, the 9th Battalion will side-slip and move into the area at present occupied by "B" and "D" Companies of the 10th Battalion. The remnants of "B" and "D" Companies, 10th Battalion meanwhile moving into the area occupied by "A" Company. It is understood that the area at present occupied by the 9th Battalion will be occupied by the amalgamated 11th and 12th Battalions.
4. Company, Platoon and Sub Unit Commanders should fully explain to their men the object of the scheme and its working, in order to do away with any possibility of misunderstanding. It is easily foreseen that such an obvious organisation should take place and any Officer who is not familiar with its inner workings can obtain all the necessary information from the Central Office.

MEMORANDUM - - AMALGAMATION

HOMECULTURE AND ADMINISTRATION. In future the combined Units 9th & 10th Battalions will be known as the 910th Australian Infantry Battalion, and will be administered as follows till further orders :-

- (a) Two distinct Units commanded by C.O.s under supervision and control of C.O. amalgated Units. These Units will be known as "A" (9th) and "B" (10th) Sub Battalions.
- (b) Staffs at present carried on Battalion Headquarters will remain, except that the functionary duties of Adjutant will be carried out by an Assistant, and that of R.Q.Ms by R.Q.M.Sgts.
- (c) One Central Control (including central Q.Ms Store) and two sub office. The former will be the channel through which all correspondence affecting a higher formation is to be sent.
Brigade will deal direct with Central Control Office and from there all communications connected with sub-Battalions will be distributed.
- (d) All matters effecting the amalgated Units as a whole will be dealt with by Central Control Office, such as drafts, guards, Training, Transport etc.
- (e) The whole of the Mobilisation Stores (and indents to complete) on charge to the 9th Battalion will be handed into Care forthwith. Stores on charge to 10th Battalion will be retained and constitute that for the amalgated Battalions.
- (f) Sub-Battalion Routine orders will continue to be issued by C.Os concerned on matters only effecting their interior administration. Copies will be submitted to Central Office daily.
- (g) War diaries will be maintained individually by Sub-Battalions and submitted monthly to Records section direct.
- (h) Punishments and awards. C.O. amalgated Battalions will deal with all cases meriting a C.Os award. Sub-Battalions will be duly notified through Central Office of the time and place at which Orderly Room will be held.
- (i) Promotions. Any promotions required will be first submitted to Central Office for approval.
- (j) All matters effecting the supply of rations, indents for clothing equipment, etc., will be submitted by Sub-Battalions to the Central Q.M. Arrangements will be made by Central Q.M. with the supply Officer that Sub-Battalions draw their rations separately for the time being.
- (k) Sub-Battalion Commanders will be held responsible for all prisoners at present in sub-Battalion guard rooms.
- (l) Transport. Affiliated transport of 9th and 10th Battalions complete to establishment of one Battalion will constitute that for amalgated Battalions.
- (m) Bands. Bands of 9th and 10th Battalions will amalgate and pass under the command of Bandmaster 10th Battalion
- (n) Amalgated Bands and Transport will come under direct control of Central Office.

(o) On departure of next draft, sub-Battalions will cease to exist, but Assistant Adjutants will be retained and records connected with their respective Battalions will be kept separately. The Central Control Office will then become the B.O.R. of the 910th Battalion.

1. PARADE. - A Battalion Parade of 910th Battalion will be held at 0850 to-morrow, 21st inst., ~~new~~ ^{new} parade ground. One marker per Company of each Sub Battalion will report to R.S.M. on Parade Ground at 0845.
DRESS :- Officers - Caps and Open Tunics.
Other Ranks - Belts and Sidearms and Rifles.
Gloves will be worn.
Every available man will attend this parade.
2. DISPOSITIONS. - The Battalion will form up in Mass, "B" Sub Battalion on the right, "A" Sub Battalion on the left. Companies will consist of 4 Platoons of 25 each. The balance after completing to 25 per platoon will be amalgamated irrespectively of Companies into a composite platoon. Platoons will be numbered from 1 onwards for the purpose of drill, notwithstanding their present numbers.
3. MOUNTED OFFICERS. - Commanding Officer, Adjutant, Commanding Officers Sub Battalions and Company Commanders will be mounted. Horses will be supplied by Transport Officer and be on ground at 0845. Stirrups will be adjusted by 0855 when the dressing of the Battalion will be complete.
4. DRESSING. - The Battalion will be dressed in two (2) minutes.
5. HANDING OVER. - The Battalion will be handed over to Commanding Officer Composite Battalion by Commanding Officer "B" Sub Battalion, after the Battalion has been told off by Companies and Platoons.
6. PARADE STATES. - Sub Battalion Parade States will be submitted to Central Office at 0840.
7. QUARTERMASTER. - R.Q.M., R.Q.M.S. and C.Q.M.Ss. will attend Battalion Parade from 0855 to 0900 during which time the Battalion will be inspection. On completion of inspection they will be dismissed.
8. GROOMS and MEGAPHONE. - Transport Officer will arrange for an adequate number of grooms to attend this parade, and R.S.M. will ensure that Commanding Officer's Megaphone is on the ground at 0850.
9. COMPANY PARADES & INSPECTION. - Particular care must be taken that Companies are not fallen in unduly early - sufficient time only being allowed for a rapid inspection and to march on to Battalion Parade by 0850.

10. BATTALION DISMISSAL.

The Battalion will be dismissed at 0950 when Sub Battalions will be handed over to their respective Commanding Officers. On dismissal, personnel attending Educational Classes will be marched to their Class Rooms with rifles.

+ RE FURTHER AMALGAMATION OF UNITS. +

1. It is at no time my intention to destroy the identity of the various Units as they pass under my command. Until the end each Unit will retain its own Officers and Non-Commissioned Officers.
2. This will apply even should a Battalion be reduced to a Platoon, or even less. It will still remain an independent Unit, answerable only to the Central Office, which will remain under my command. The only exception to this rule will be the Transport, which it is recognised must be a mixed Unit, so far as personnel is concerned. As this is designed to expedite the final rapid Demobilisation of the men, I feel certain that neither the personnel of the 9th, nor that of the 10th, who will be then amalgamated into a composite Unit, will do anything but give their complete support and loyalty to the Officer who for the time being may be placed at their head.
3. After the departure of the next draft to Australia, the 9th Battalion will side-slip and move into the area at present occupied by "B" and "D" Companies of the 10th Battalion - The remnants of "B" and "D" Companies, 10th Battalion meanwhile moving into the area occupied by "A" Company. It is understood that the area at present occupied by the 9th Battalion will be occupied by the amalgamated 11th and 12th Battalions.
4. Company, Platoon and Sub Unit Commanders should fully explain to their men the object of the scheme and its working, in order to do away with any possibility of misunderstanding. It is easily foreseen that such an obvious organisation should take place and any Officer who is not familiar with its inner workings can obtain all the necessary information from the Central Office.

MEMORANDUM -- ^{BATTALION} AMALGAMATION.

HOMECULTURE AND ADMINISTRATION. In future the combined Units 9th & 10th Battalions will be known as the 910th Australian Infantry Battalion, and will be administered as follows till further orders :-

- (a) Two distinct Units commanded by C.O.s under supervision and control of C.O. amalgated Units. These Units will be known as "A" (9th) and "B" (10th) Sub Battalions.
- (b) Staffs at present carried on Battalion Headquarters will remain, except that the functionary duties of Adjutant will be carried out by an Assistant, and that of R.Q.Ms by R.Q.M.Sgts.
- (c) One Central Control (including central Q.Ms Store) and two sub offices. The former will be the channel through which all correspondence affecting a higher formation is to be sent.
Brigade will deal direct with Central Control Office and from there all communications connected with sub-Battalions will be distributed.
- (d) All matters effecting the amalgated Units as a whole will be dealt with by Central Control Office, such as drafts, guards, Training, Transport etc.
- (e) The whole of the Mobilisation Stores (and indents to complete) on charge to the 9th Battalion will be handed into Base forthwith. Stores on charge to 10th Battalion will be retained and constitute that for the amalgated Battalions.
- (f) Sub-Battalion Routine orders will continue to be issued by C.O.s concerned on matters only effecting their interior administration. Copies will be submitted to Central Office daily.
- (g) War diaries will be maintained individually by Sub-Battalions and submitted monthly to Records section direct.
- (h) Punishments and awards. C.O. amalgated Battalions will deal with all cases meriting a C.O.s award. Sub-Battalions will be duly notified through Central Office of the time and place at which Orderly Room will be held.
- (i) Promotions. Any promotions required will be first submitted to Central Office for approval.
- (j) All matters effecting the supply of rations, indents for clothing equipment, etc., will be submitted by Sub-Battalions to the Central Q.M. Arrangements will be made by Central Q.M. with the supply Officer that Sub-Battalions draw their rations separately for the time being.
- (k) Sub-Battalion Commanders will be held responsible for all prisoners at present in sub-Battalion guard rooms.
- (l) Transport. Affiliated transport of 9th and 10th Battalions complete to establishment of one Battalion will constitute that for amalgated Battalions.
- (m). Bands. Bands of 9th and 10th Battalions will amalgate and pass under the command of Bandmaster 10th Battalion
- (n). Amalgated Bands and Transport will come under direct control of Central Office.

(o) On departure of next draft, sub-Battalions will cease to exist, but Assistant Adjutants will be retained and records connected with their respective Battalions will be kept separately. The Central Control Office will then become the D.O.R. of the 910th Battalion. C.O.s Sub-Battalions will make all necessary arrangements in the posts of Officers and other Administrative personnel to ensure that Demobilisation does not effect in any way the administration.
