Belgium	Jan 31 ¹⁹¹⁹		<p>During this month the canteen still remained at Florennes which was the Railhead for the Division. Many purchases were made outside the E.F.C. the most important one being a large quantity of German goods salvaged by the 2nd Aust Division. They were sold by auction and the D. C.O. purchased in large quantities Wines, Spices, Cigars, Vegetables etc, they were afterwards sold to Units in the 4th Division at a very low rate of charge, and was greatly appreciated.</p> <p>Purchases for the Month amounted to Francs 261,996-55 and Sales Francs 407,294-40.</p> <p>January even surpassed the month of December</p>
