(334) GAME SHOOTING.

Complaints have been received of men shooting game, & cases have occurred of men being wounded by rifle shots apparently fired at game. The attention of all ranks is drawn to School Standing Orders, para 6, sub-para (d), and G.R.O. 1297 is republished for information:-

1297:- " As cases still occur of Officers & Other Ranks pursuing & killing game, it is notified for information that the hunting, shooting, or killing of game (which includes hares & rabbits) by nets, snares, or other methods, is strictly prohibited."

Strong disciplinary action will be taken against all offenders.

(335) EXEMPLARY CONDUCT OF BRITISH PRISONERS OF WAR.

The following extract from G.R.O. 5040 is published for information:-

The following from captured German Documents are published for information:-

EXTRACT FROM THE EXAMINATION OF A SERGEANT & FIVE PRIVATES OF THE 51st. AUSTRALIAN BATTALION, WHO WERE CAPTURED ON THE 5th. AUGUST, 1918.

" The Sergeant who is the only one who has served a long " & unbroken period with the troops, refused to make any " military statement & could not be shaken in his resolve " "by any means employed."
