Nurses who cannot be employed or accommodated are to be granted 10/- per diem subsistence allowance (1404/23/48.)

	31.3.19.		<u>STATISTICS FOR PERIOD FROM 29.2.19 to 29.3.19.</u> 5D.1 records that 14 ships with a personnel of 13,259 were dealt with during the period. 5D.2 records an expenditure of £7,685 - 8 - 8 Subsistence and £8,757.15.2. pay to 1,940 men on account of Non-Military Employment (including education.) Fees amounting to ££716.- were paid on account of 68 men. 5D.3. Extended leave in U.K. has been granted to 250 men and leave to return to Australia at their own expense to 46 men, and with 50 days pay to 2 men. In addition 105 applications in all for deferred pay have been approved, and 411 Army Forms 543, involving an amount of £8,207 - 10 - 0, to be credited to Family Passages Account, have been handed to Accountancy for action. 5D.4. effected 403 discharges in U.K. 5D.5. records that 3,661 men were recommended for Non-Military Employment, and 1,780 men were approved through Part II Orders.
