	30. 4. 19.		<p><u>Statistics for Period from 30.3.19 to 26.4.19.</u></p> <p>5D.1 Records that 18 ships with a personnel of 16,864 were dealt with during the period.</p> <p>5D.2 Records an expenditure of £21,806 - 14 - 5 subsistence and £21,195 - 13 - 6 Pay to 3,946 men on account of Non-Military Employment (including Education.) Fees amounting to £1,556 - 13 - 4 were paid on account of 123 men.</p> <p>5D.3 Extended leave in U.K. has been granted to 201 men and leave to return to Australia to 88 men at their own expense; and to 2 men with 50 days pay. In addition 323 applications for deferred pay have been approved and 191 Army Forms 543 involving an amount of £4,435 - 15 - 0 to be credited to Family Passages Account have been handed to Accountancy for action.</p> <p>5D.4 effected 355 Discharges in U.K. Gratuity due at discharge has been credited to 214 men amounting to £3,705.-</p> <p>5D.5. records that 3,208 men were recommended for Non-Military Employment and 2,656 men approved through Part II Orders.</p>	595
