TRAFFIC.

Traffic was reported going well everywhere, roads muddy, but otherwise in fair condition.

SPEED TRAPS.

Speed traps were held in the various areas, only 6 contra-ventions were recorded.

Major A.B. Douglas Brown, D.S.O. took over on 19.11.18 as Assistant Provost Marshal, Australian Corps.

CÉAIM was lodged by Mme FOSSE under date 6.11.18 for fire on premises at CARDONETTE, damage estimated at 50,000 francs (insured for 25000 francs).

The General Discipline of the troops throughout the month has been very good.
